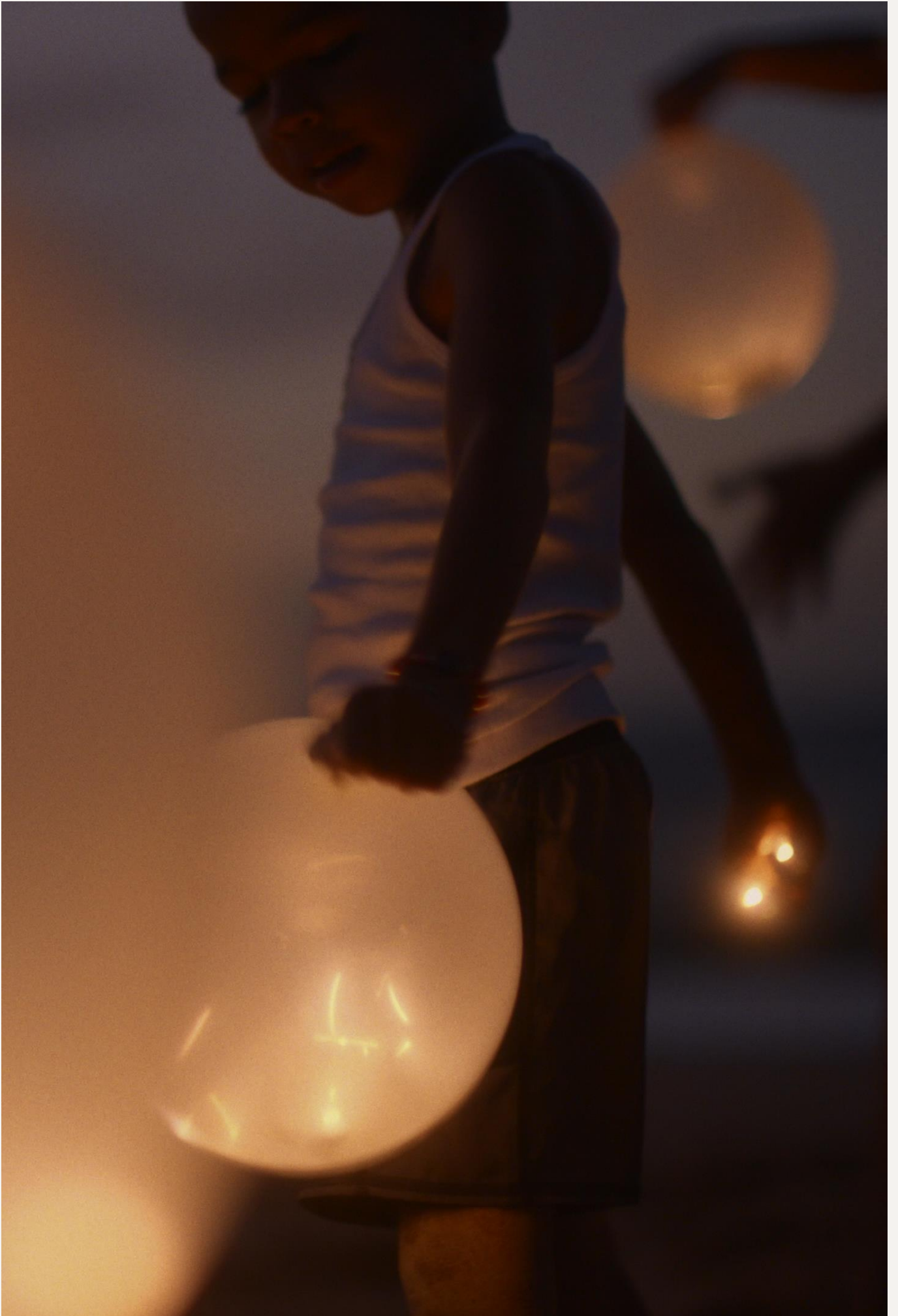
Towards a Harmonious Soul

Families gathered, offerings were prepared, prayers were spoken and gratitude was shared, not simply to mark the passing of time, but to restore harmony within before stepping into a new chapter.

Memayu Hayuning Jiwa honours the nurturing of the soul, inviting a moment to reflect on the path travelled, give thanks for the experiences that have shaped us, rekindle meaningful connections and embrace the year ahead in harmony.

31 DECEMBER 2026

Before the First Dawn

As daylight fades over the Kedu Plain, guests are welcomed into an evening inspired by the customs of ancient Java.

Grounded by the land (pertiwi), guests leave behind the hustle and bustle of everyday life to enter a space where time moves differently, arriving fully present in the shadow of Borobudur Temple. From here, blessings invite reflection and gratitude for the journey travelled (apah), preparing the soul for the path ahead.

As the evening deepens, carried by the evening breeze (bayu), conversations unfold around a shared table, where stories, flavours and traditions draw family, friends and newfound companions closer together.

Illuminated by fire (teja), the night gathers energy as performances fill the evening with a sense of celebration, carrying guests towards the turning of the year before the sound of the gong heralds a new beginning.

The Journey Begins

BOROBUDUR TEMPLE

19:15

Arriving at Borobudur, the transition begins with an andong, a traditional Javanese horse-drawn carriage that transports you to the evening's celebration. The pace slows, allowing the temple and its surroundings to be experienced much as they once were.

Bregada Procession

A bregada procession leads the way to the welcome cocktail reception, where ceremonial guards in traditional regalia draw on the customs of Java's royal courts.

The next chapter of the evening is written in light. Candles are illuminated one by one until the silhouette of Borobudur begins to emerge in shimmering light. Wishes are offered. Light is shared.

Borobudur's reliefs continue at the table. Historic flavours are presented in a parade of Javanese dishes, accompanied by cultural performances throughout the evening.

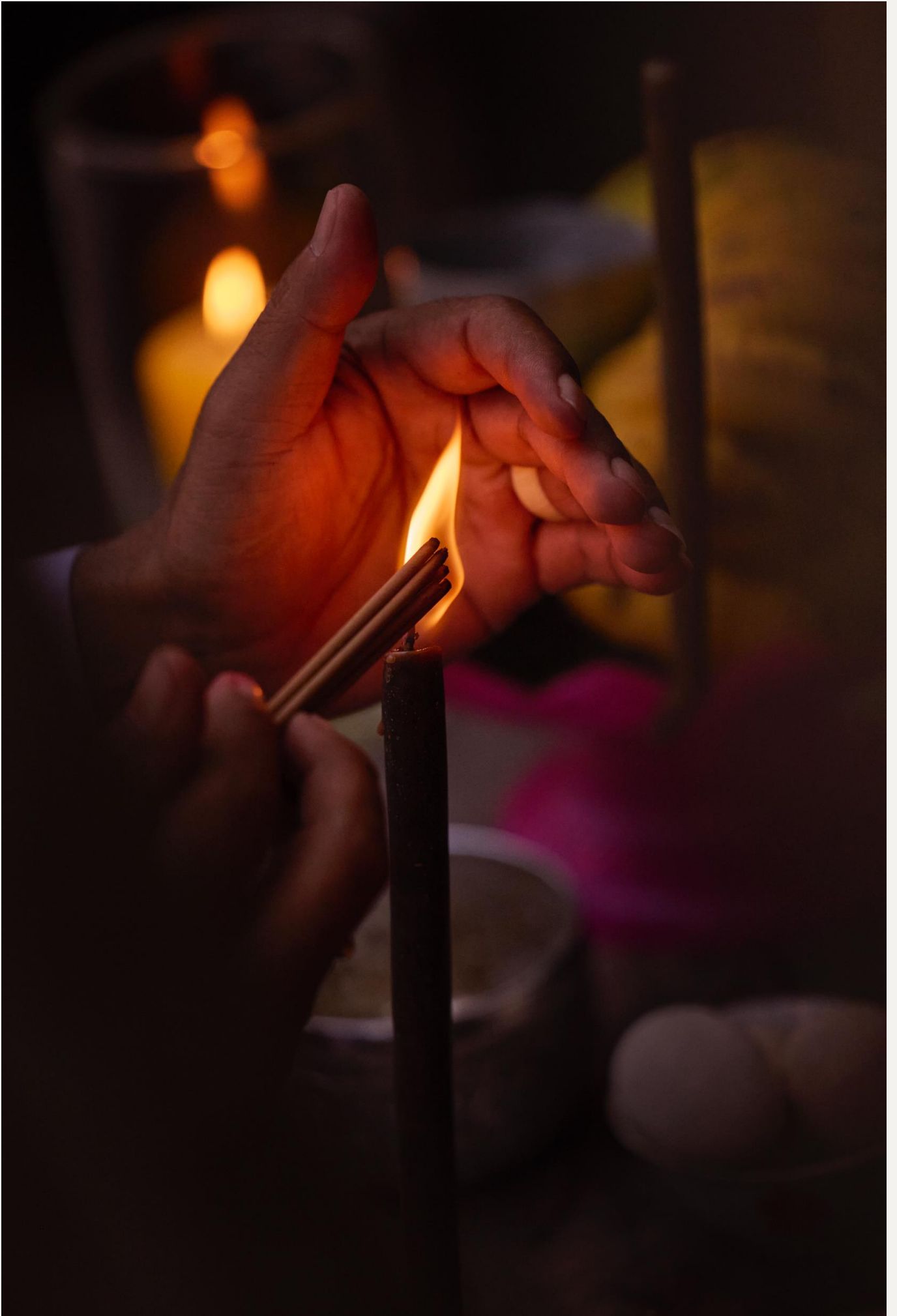
By the light of the fire, written wishes are offered to the flame, allowing hopes and prayers to rise skyward—sending our deepest intentions beyond the earthly realm.
