Karangasem Regency, beneath the majestic Mount Agung, is one of Bali's most traditional regions, full of hidden treasures. Amankila occupies a breathtaking hilltop spot with unobstructed views of the Lombok Strait. Its 31 spacious stilted pavilions, surrounded by frangipani and bougainvillea, connect to the resort's facilities via elevated walkways, offering exceptional hillside vistas.

#### LOCATION

- Cliffside position overlooking the Lombok Strait in East Bali
- Near to Manggis, Candi Dasa, Tenganan, and other villages in Karangasem, Bali's most traditional regency

#### GETTING THERE

- Around a 1.5-hour drive north of Denpasar's I Gusti Ngurah Rai International Airport (DPS).
- The airport (DPS) is served by carriers including Singapore Airlines, Garuda Indonesia, Qatar Airways, Emirates, Qantas Airways, Turkish Airlines, KLM Airlines, Korean Air, Cathay Pacific, Thai Airways, Malaysia Airlines, Scoot, and Jetstar
- Cars are equipped with Wi-Fi, Bluetooth sound systems, snacks, refreshments, and printed Jakarta Post newspaper

## Accommodation

Raised on stilts and thatched with alang-alang, Amankila's 31 pavilions – 12 with private pools – enjoy ocean or garden views, and consummate privacy. Decorated with inlaid pearl and coconut-shell furniture, all pavilions feature canopied King-size beds, a living area, a large bathroom with a soaking tub, and an outdoor terrace.

KILASARI POOL VILLA

- Situated high on the hillside
- Vast view of Amuk Bay and the mountainside
- Private 11.7-metre infinity pool with sunbeds
- Outdoor terrace living area and outdoor daybed which can be covered by bamboo blinds
- Separate bathtub and shower in terrazzo finish

INDRAKILA POOL VILLA

- Perched on the hillside
- Expansive views stretching past the temple and far along the East coast of Bali
- Private 9.2-metre pool ensconced by a paras-stone
- Lounging balé
- Outdoor terrace living area and outdoor daybed which can be covered by bamboo blinds
- Separate bathtub and shower in terrazzo finish

AMANKILA TWO-BEDROOM VILLA

- Serviced by a private butler
- 2 bedrooms open onto a large terrace
- Views of the beach and the Amuk Bay
- Ideal for guests wanting complete privacy, or for 2 couples who wish to stay together
- Private 10.5-metre pool ensconced by a paras-stone
- 2 lounging balés, each on the side of the private swimming pool
- Outdoor terrace living area and outdoor daybed which can be covered by bamboo blinds
- Separate bathtub and shower in terrazzo finish

### ARVA

- 32 seated for dining
- Open for dinner and serves exclusively Italian menu
- Blending Italy's farm-to-table traditions with Balinese ingredients
- Set beside Amankila's three-tier swimming pool
- Panoramic night sea views

### TERRACE BAR

- Seats 22 guests
- Located alongside Sandikala
- Ideal spot to linger for sunset drinks or celebrations with friends or family or for refreshing drinks and sundowners
- Ranging from snacks, lunch items, light beverages, soft drinks, juices, mocktails, cocktails, liqueurs, spirits, wines, selections of cigars and Shisha
- Overlooks the three-tier swimming pool

### THE BEACH CLUB

- Seats 12 guests on the terrace area and 18 seats in the inside area
- Open for lunch
- Drinks and light meals can also be enjoyed in 8 secluded lounging bales right on the sand



#### HARVEST TABLE

- Can accommodate 8 guests
- Situated in a private pavilion next to Sandikala
- An ideal venue for private dining and cooking class
- Breathtaking views of the Lombok Strait

#### TAMANSARI BALÉ

- Overlooking the Buitan Valley, Mount Agung and the eastern shoreline
- Ideal for sunrise breakfast, sunset cocktails, or traditional satay dinners
- Best experienced in the morning

## Experiences

Amankila is ideally placed for exploring local craft villages, the verdant countryside and the region's royal ruins. Stretching from the hilltop to the private beach, the property lies within reach of atmospheric temples and artisan villages.

### KARANGASEM ROYAL DINNER

In collaboration with the Karangasem Royal Family, this intimate culinary journey is set within the private grounds of Ujung Water Palace. It begins with a tour of the estate, followed by a dinner inspired by the region's culinary traditions. Each course is accompanied by the sound of the Penting, lending a timeless grace to this royal experience.

### SUNRISE CRUISE

Two jukung-style outriggers, Aman XII (50 ft) and Aman XIV (40 ft) are available to charter for an exquisite sunrise cruise. The sunrise cruise is also best enjoyed with pairing activities of snorkeling, to further explore East Bali's pristine reefs, and breakfast on the boat.

### EAST BALI TOUR

Amankila's East Bali tour takes approximately three hours and showcases the highlights of the region. Travel in a private vehicle with your own driver and explore East Bali at your own pace. You may choose to visit Tenganan, one of Bali Aga's villages; Ujung Water Palace, to gain insight into the region's regal past; or the Samsara Living Museum, for a deeper understanding of Bali's traditional lifecycle.

The Beach Club offers an array of thrilling water sports equipment and activities, including kayaks, stand-up paddle boards, and boogie boards. From beach bats to soccer, volleyball, or frisbee, our beach attendants are happy to provide the equipment and organize a team.
