Amankila and the community

Saraswati Putra Manggis Kindergarten is the only kindergarten in Manggis Village, home to Amankila. Its poor physical condition, worsened by the 2018 Lombok earthquake, brought it to our attention as a potential CSR project.

In 2019, Amankila made its first visit and found that only one room was being used for two classes, including the library. Sanitation was inadequate, the building was not suitable as a classroom, and resources such as books, educational materials, and toys were limited. The playground was also in disrepair.

In response, Amankila raised funds to renovate the kindergarten: repairing the roof, walls, and sanitation, providing new furniture, educational toys, storybooks, stationery, and improving the playground.
