To complement these revitalising amenities, a large private lounge provides space for relaxation, as well as a private outdoor Jacuzzi. Spa Houses are available for half- or full-day private experiences.

HAMMAM

With origins in the Roman Empire, hammams hold cultural significance across regions, from the Middle East and Turkey to Morocco. The treatment includes a steam bath experience, body scrub and invigorating massage, with various soaps and oils used to exfoliate and cleanse the skin.

BANYA

Rooted in Eastern European and Scandinavian culture, the Banya Sauna Treatment includes time in the sauna room where oak or birch leaves, known as *veniks*, are used to massage, stimulate and exfoliate the skin. The Spa Houses are designed for private or group sessions. To personalise your group sessions or celebrations, a maximum of four guests can be arranged with advance reservation.
