
Rahajeng Nyepi

Mecaru Ceremony

Mecaru Ceremony is a sacred Balinese purification ritual conducted on *Pengerupukan* Day, the eve of Nyepi, to cleanse the environment and restore harmony between humans, nature, and the spiritual realm. The ceremony involves presenting *banten caru*, special offerings to appease unseen forces and drive away negative energies.

Following the *Mecaru* Ceremony, a *Baleganjur* procession will take place, encircling the resort with the powerful rhythms of a traditional Balinese gamelan ensemble. The intense percussions and dynamic chants of Baleganjur were historically used to accompany warriors into battle and are now an essential part of religious ceremonies, believed to dispel malevolent spirits. As the hypnotic beats resonate through the resort, they mark the transition into a period of stillness and renewal, leading up to the sacred Day of Silence.

Ogoh-ogoh Parade

On the eve of Nyepi, the peaceful surroundings of Sengkidu Village transform into a lively spectacle with the Ogoh-Ogoh Parade—one of Bali's most anticipated traditions. Towering, intricately crafted figures symbolizing negative forces are carried through the streets, accompanied by the rhythmic sounds of gamelan, creating a mesmerizing and energetic atmosphere. This ritual is believed to drive away malevolent spirits before the island enters a day of total stillness.
