The Amanoi Experience

Located on a striking and secluded stretch of Vietnam's coastline within the lush Nui Chua National Park, Amanoi is a natural paradise.

Here at the threshold of land and sea, Amanoi offers an array of outdoor adventures and authentic cultural experiences.

Trek amid myriad wildlife in our neighbouring UNESCO-listed Biosphere Reserve, embark on guided snorkelling expeditions of gin-clear waters or cruise the coast by glass-bottomed kayak.

On land, balance body and mind at Amanoi's lakeside spa before delving into the ancient world of the region's Cham people. Visit panoramic hilltop towers dating back to the 12th century or indulge in a sacred Cham dinner accompanied by a ceremonial blessing amid Amanoi's mystic jungle.

Catamaran

Catamaran Day Cruise

Drift into the rhythm of the sea with a catamaran journey across the calm, azure waters of Vinh Hy Bay. Whether bathed in the soft light of morning sunrise or chasing the final golden rays of sunset, each moment onboard is touched by nature's quiet splendour - all observed from the gentle sway of the water, surrounded by the beauty of the bay

Savour delicious canapés and beverages, including a curated selection of alcoholic beverages, as the sea breeze stirs gentle conversation and the crew tends to every detail. Between sips and sea spray, dive into crystal waters for a snorkel, glide on a paddleboard, cast a line, or simply let the coastline unfold before the eyes - a moving painting of cliffs, coves and sky.

Night Fishing

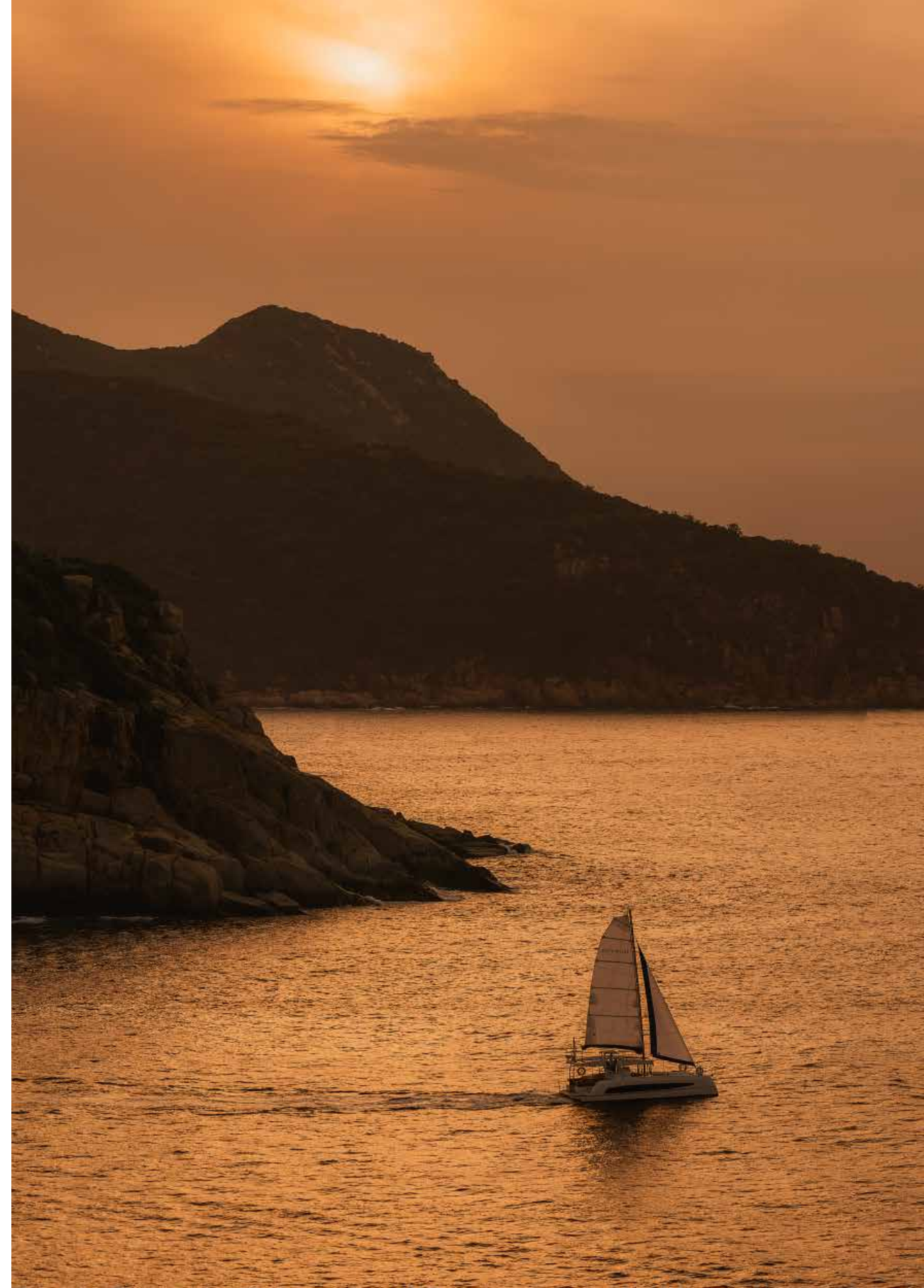
As evening falls over Vinh Hy Bay, the catamaran becomes a tranquil retreat under the stars. This peaceful journey invites guests to experience the quiet tradition of night fishing - a local ritual brought to life by the soft glow of onboard lights. Cast your line into the darkened sea to catch a variety of species, from fish to squid, sip a drink, and let the stillness of the bay and the rhythm of the waves create a truly memorable evening.

For both day and night cruise experiences:
A minimum of two guests is required. For a group of three or more, or for a half-day programme, please refer to the price list in the annex. Reservations are required at least 24 hours in advance. Weather permitting.

Post-Cruise Recovery Ritual

After a day of drifting across the crystalline waters of Vinh Hy Bay aboard our private catamaran, ease back into stillness with this soothing, restorative treatment. Designed to hydrate sun-kissed skin and calm the body after time at sea, this ritual offers a quiet moment of renewal.

Begin with a fresh coconut body polish to gently exfoliate and nourish sun-kissed skin, followed by a mineral-rich seaweed and aloe vera wrap to deeply restore moisture and calm the body. A Cryo bulb therapy refreshes the face, while an Aman Nourishing Gold Algae Face Mask delivers protective care. With calming aromas and flowing movements, this ritual leaves you radiant, centred, and completely at ease.



Wellness Activities

Daily Wellness Class

Complimentary. Daily at 8am & 2.30pm at Aman Spa. Please refer to the Wellness Class Schedule or dial '2' for more information.

Enjoy the day with our wellness class, refreshing your mind and body with our expert coaches. Guiding you through a one-hour workout session, classes rotate throughout the week. Disciplines include Yoga, Sound Meditations, Fitness, Mat Pilates and more intensive workouts. Classes are rotated with different activities every week.

Half-Day Spa Programme

For additional treatments, please refer to the Spa menu.

This half-day programme encompasses a rewarding movement session, revitalising spa treatment and some welcomed time out.

- 60-minute movement session (Yoga, Pilates or Personal Training);
- 60-minute hydrotherapy experience;
- 90-minute body treatment;
- Light refreshments (including fresh coconut juice, hot tea and one non-alcoholic meal)

Visiting Wellness Specialists

Throughout the year, Amanoi's residency programme draws an international roster of holistic health experts and well-being practitioners to the Aman Spa. Alongside the in-house team of therapists, these specialists share knowledge and insight of the latest healing techniques and research through a limited-edition programme of retreats and experiences.

Wellness Villas

Book dedicated time out at one of Amanoi's Lake Wellness Pool Villa and Forest Wellness Pool Villa, each of which benefit from dedicated therapists and integrated spa facilities, including treatment rooms, steam rooms, plunge pools, Jacuzzis and private pools. A banya or hammam completes the space.

Hydrotherapy Suites

Amanoi's Spa offers two private hydrotherapy suites, each featuring a heated stone treatment table, steam room, Jacuzzi and plunge pool. These may be booked with or without a treatment. To bolster the immune system, we recommend a body exfoliation followed by time in the steam room, the Jacuzzi and plunge pool.





Treks

Hugged by hills, Amanoi is a gateway to the 29,000-hectare Nui Chua National Park which rests within the Nui Chua UNESCO Biosphere Reserve - a rugged wonderland of diverse landscapes where hikers are rewarded with sweeping panoramas and myriad wildlife at every turn. From the resort, a network of trails lead guests on family-friendly rambles to picnics on secret beaches, or more challenging treks to the rock formations of Bai Da and the dramatic bay views of Goga Peak.

As it can get very hot during the day, we recommend trekking either early in the morning or late in the afternoon. Hats, walking shoes or trainers and sunscreen are recommended.

Treks are graded based on the following scale. Please note, weather conditions may impact the perceived difficulty level:

LEVEL ONE

Easygoing, this trek should not elevate heart rate too much.

LEVEL TWO

A light trek that should increase heart rate a little and requires trainers and reasonable attire.

LEVEL THREE

A trek that boosts heart rate and requires a moderate level of fitness. Proper walking attire and shoes or trainers recommended.

LEVEL FOUR

A more challenging trek for those who are experienced, physically fit and like something of a challenge. Minimal climbing may be involved.

LEVEL FIVE

This trek requires physical fitness, endurance and a sense of adventure. Many sections will include climbing up rocky or wild terrain. Only manageable if wearing the proper attire.



Goga Peak

Level two. Approximately 15-20 minutes each way.
 Not recommended for children under eight years old and expected mothers.
 Distance: 1km.

This short hike follows an inclining pathway up to Goga Peak. Best enjoyed at sunrise and the ambiance of sunset, spectacular views greet hikers at the apex, with Vinh Hy Bay, the East Sea, coastal rock formations and the southern city of Phan Rang unfolding all around.

Wild Cat Trek

Level two-three. Approximately 60 minutes.
 Not recommended for children.
 Distance: 1.5km.

Follow in the footsteps of the wild civet during this on-site hike. Snaking through the national park, the route allows hikers to discover different flora and fauna en route to a memorable viewpoint overlooking the lush surrounding landscape.

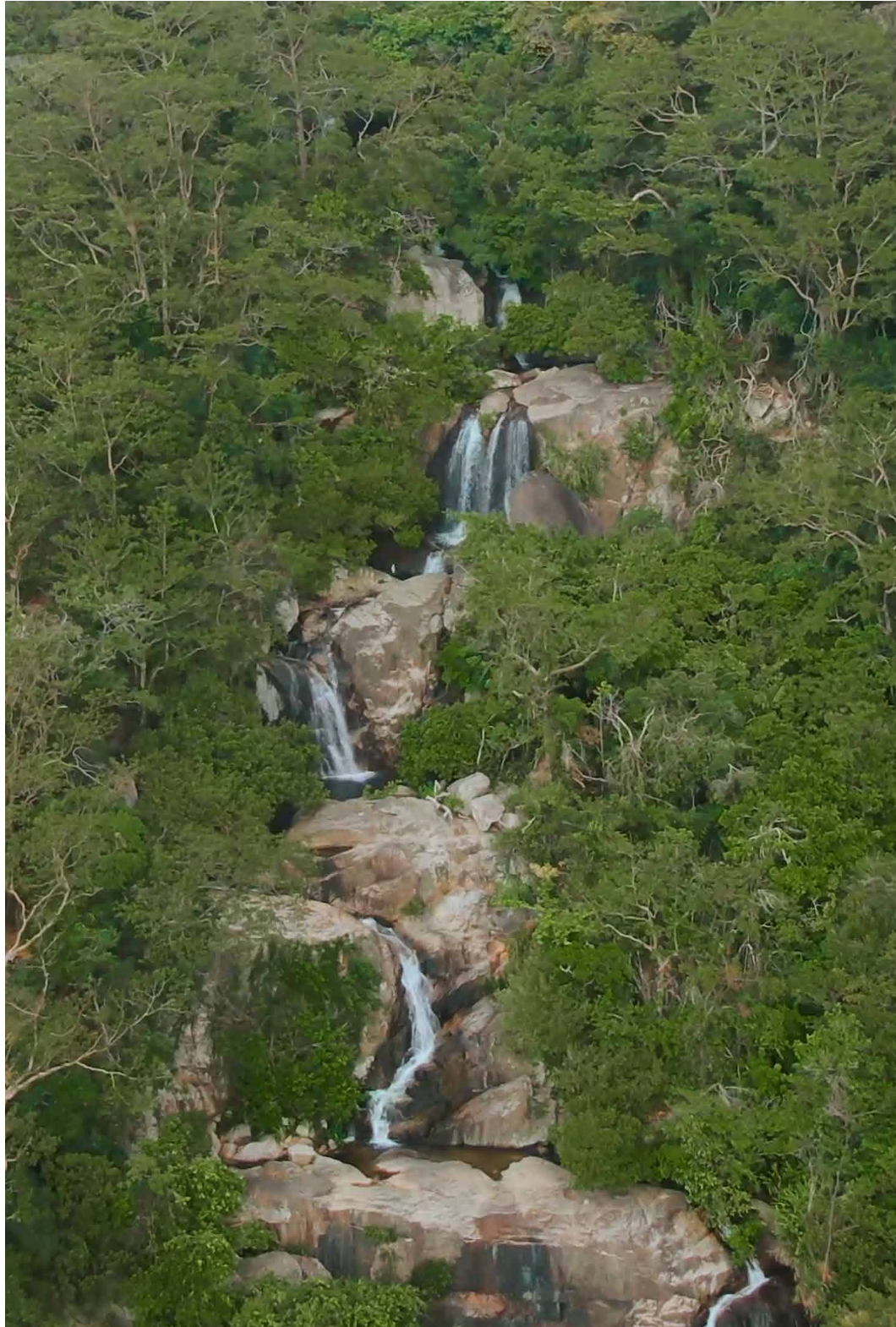
Trek and Picnic in Rock Park

Level two-three. Approximately 60-90 minutes; two and a half hours if combined with picnic.
 Distance: 3km.

A 20-minute drive from Amanoi brings you to Bai Da (Rock Park). Vacating your vehicle, a gentle walk leads to an elevated region of incredible natural rock formations. Here, within Rock Park, you will enjoy a morning picnic prepared by Amanoi's Culinary team accompanied by expansive sea and sky views.

Following your morning repast, take a scenic downhill trek towards Bai Thit Beach, a turtle conservation area. Then, continue along the coastline, over sandy stretches and large rocks, and up a somewhat steep trail, towards Bai Da.





Cau Gay & Jungle Trek

Level two-three.

Duration: Two and a half to four hours.

Distance: 3km.

Cau Gay and Jungle Trek immerses walkers in both nature and local life. This trek begins with a morning walk to the village of Cau Gay, home to just 55 households from the Raglai community. Dedicated to preserving their distinctive culture, as you explore the village you will encounter traditional houses made of mud and straw, a small kindergarten and primary school and locals going about their daily activities.

The journey continues through the forest, where you will learn about the matrilineal community and visit local farms with a variety of fruit trees and vegetables. Depending on the season, trekkers will have the opportunity to witness local harvesting.

Ba Tang Waterfall Trek

Level four-five. Approximately three hours, excluding rest time; five hours if combined with a picnic. The trek duration depends on fitness level of participants.

Distance: 9km.

Ba Tang, or Three-Layer Waterfall, is one of the region's hidden gems. Setting off from the nearby village of Da Hang, a 20-minute drive from Amanoï, this hike commences along the valley floor, crossing over streams to take in local farms and picturesque countryside scenery.

From here, your guide will lead you on a one-hour trek through the forest to reach Ba Tang waterfall. Exhale and cool off with a refreshing swim under billowing waters. On your descent, enjoy a unique breakfast or lunchtime picnic overlooking the rice fields.

Ho Treo – Hang Lake & Da Vach Trek

Level four-five. Approximately three to three and a half in total, depending on fitness level of participants.

Distance: 7km.

Named by local forest rangers, the Ho Treo (Hanging Lake) trek's starting point is located a 10-minute drive away from Amanoï. Adjacent to Vinh Hy village, this small lake reveals itself after a 25-minute energetic hike through the dense forest of Núi Chua National Park. Da Vach is one of our more intensive treks, beginning at the Ho Treo and continuing up through forestland and rocky outcrops. Dramatic coastline views are just rewards for keen hikers.

Núi Chúa – King Mountain Trek

Level five+. The trek takes approximately nine hours.

Distance: 21km.

The experience includes lunch, a tour guide, insurance, park tickets and a porter.

This 21-kilometre hiking route is best suited to experienced hikers with a good level of fitness. Commencing at Da Hang village, the trail – encompassing lush flora and fauna and meandering streams – ascends to Núi Chúa, King Mountain, and concludes in Cau Gay village of the Raglai people. Rising to 1,039 metres, at its apex, Núi Chúa offers panoramic views of the entire region.

Reservations are required at least 72 hours in advance and are subject to a minimum 48-hour cancellation policy.



Water Sports

Hobie Cat Sailing

Complimentary | Weather permitting.
Maximum 4 persons.

Explore Vinh Hy Bay and its surrounding areas by Hobie Cat. Admire the granite-embraced resort from your sailboat, guided by our Water Sports team. Reservations can be made with our Activity team. Please note, life vests are compulsory.

Kayaking

Complimentary | Weather permitting.

Home to a variety of tropical fish and beautiful coral, explore Vinh Hy Bay via single, double or glass kayak. Discover inlets and witness local fishermen at work. Our Activity team can assist with reservations and pricing for a private guided trip. Life vests are compulsory.

Windsurfing

Complimentary | Weather permitting.

Feel the movements of the wind and waves in this exhilarating water sport, which combines surfing and sailing. Suitable for all levels, our team can provide basic guidance for beginners.

Dinghy Sailing

Complimentary | Weather permitting.

Glide across the gentle waters of Vinh Hy Bay in a relaxed dinghy sailing session designed exclusively for experienced sailors. This hands-on experience offers a refreshing way to connect with the sea and coastal breeze while enjoying the art of sailing.

Stand Up Paddleboarding

Complimentary | Weather permitting.

Take in the bay's marine life from above with our carbon-fibre paddleboards. A great form of exercise, while enjoying the surrounding natural beauty, stand up paddleboarding is best enjoyed on calm, sunny days.

Snorkelling

Complimentary | Weather permitting.
Additional fee for for guided snorkelling and reaching outer snorkeling sites by boat.
Snorkelling gear is provided (fins, mask, life jacket).
Recommended time is from 10am-3pm.

Explore the Vinh Hy Bay conservation area's rich corals, encompassing a variety of staghorn, plate and brain corals, as well as a diverse range of marine life, including colourful shoals of tropical fish, through guided snorkelling sessions.

Kitesurfing

An additional transportation charge applies. Pricing varies based on the selected transportation type. Lesson fee can be settled at Sorrento Beach Club. Equipment rental is available with extra charges. 24-hour advanced booking is required. Weather permitting.

A 20-minute drive from Amanoi, My Hoa Lagoon is a popular destination in Ninh Thuan (now Khanh Hoa) for kitesurfers. Lessons are conducted by Sorrento Beach Club's professional instructor, with a range of options available from two to 12- hour sessions. Lessons usually commence at 10am and are staggered throughout the day depending on the height of the tide, wind strength and your skill level. Our Activity team will advise on the wind and tide conditions at the time of booking. Long board shorts, a long-sleeve top and a quick-dry top, sunglasses with a strap, sunscreen and a hat are recommended.





Fitness & Sports

Archery

Suitable for adults and children aged 12 and above. Our Activity team will accompany guests during the session to assist and ensure safety. Complimentary.

A popular sport, dating back to the 15th century, archery is great for improving focus, coordination and balance, and building stability and physical strength. Adjacent to the Beach Club, Amanoï's archery field is an ideal setting for beginners to learn the basic principles of how to use a bow and arrow, and perfect your aim.

Tennis

Private lessons with our local Tennis Coach are available with surcharge. 24-hour booking in advance is required.

The Tennis Courts are located by the main entrance to Amanoï and are complimentary for guests. The courts are floodlit and suitable for day or night time use. Our Activity team can arrange all equipment and find a tennis partner for you.

Pickleball

Private lessons with our local coach are available with surcharge. 24-hour booking in advance is required.

Enjoy a game of pickleball - a lively blend of tennis, badminton, and table tennis, set against the resort's peaceful natural backdrop. Whether you're playing solo or with a partner, paddles and balls are provided for your convenience, with the option to book private coaching sessions to refine your skills.

Running Circuit

Trails around Amanoï are perfect for early morning or late-afternoon runs. Design your own circuit:

- Main Gate to Beach Club - 1.1 km
- Beach Club to Central Pavilion - 1.5 km
- Central Pavilion to Beach Club - 0.9 km
- Main Gate to Central Pavilion - 1.7 km

Golf

A 25-minute drive from Amanoï, Anara Binh Tien Golf Course offers golfers pristine fairways. Situated beside Binh Tien beach, the 18-hole course is equipped with five different teeing options and pin positions for each hole.

Another option is KN Golf Links Cam Ranh - a 90-minute drive from Amanoï, the 29-hole course is designed by Greg Norman.

An hour and 45-minute drive from the resort, the 76-hectare Diamond Bay Golf Course lies between the mountains and the sea. The 18-hole championship golf course was designed by Andy Dye.

An additional transportation charge applies. All golf prices vary depending on the car type and do not include golf fee, club rental and/or buggy. Kindly note that the golf courses are independently operated and not in exclusive partnership with Amanoï. Our team is delighted to assist with arrangements; however, all services are provided directly by the respective courses, and service standards may vary. Beyond Amanoi

Nui Chua National Park & UNESCO Biosphere Reserve

Awarded National Park status in 2003, Nui Chua Reserve is situated on a wide, mountainous promontory, extending into the East Sea between Cam Ranh and Phan Rang bays. Offering diverse ecosystems, flora and fauna - including some 664 plants, 72 mammals, 181 birds and 353 species of coral, the park is home to the largest known population of black-shanked douc in Vietnam, as well as pygmy loris, the Asian black bear and the large-antlered muntjac. This display of diversity led UNESCO to recognise Nui Chua as a global biosphere reserve in September 2021.

The park is also vital for the conservation of marine biodiversity, with several shouldering beaches used as nesting grounds for small numbers of marine turtles. Additionally, the fringing coral reefs are particularly rich and support a distinctly different coral community.

Amanoi can arrange guides, picnics and transport for excursions into the park.





BEYOND AMANOI: Cultural & Local Excursions

Ninh Thuan (now Khanh Hoa)'s rich and diverse cultural tapestry is graced with a vibrant heritage deeply influenced by the Cham and Raglai ethnic groups. The Cham people's legacy is prominently showcased through their captivating architecture and traditional festivals, while the Raglai's unique customs and lifestyle add a distinctiveness to the region. Local fishing villages offer a glimpse into the region's coastal traditions and the importance of the sea in shaping local life.

The Lost Kingdom of Cham

Approximately five hours.

Discover the ancient heritage of the region's Cham people, who once dominated the coast of southern Vietnam.

Bringing alive the rich and historic past of the Champa Kingdom, embark on a journey of discovery, beginning in Phan Rang with a visit to the Cham Museum. Our guide will escort you and introduce you to the history, architecture, textiles, clothing and many rituals of the Cham people. From there, the tour takes guests to the Po Klong Garai Cham Towers, dating back to the 13th century. The fascinating and well-preserved towers are a five-minute walk up a small hill and provide a 360-degree view of the surrounding region.

Salt Farm Visit

The activity is subject to seasonality. A minimum of 24 hours' advanced booking is required. Recommended visit time is from 6-8am.

The sea salt farms of Khanh Nhon and Khanh Tuong are a popular attraction in the Ninh Thuan (now Khanh Hoa) province. Considered the sunniest and driest area in Vietnam, the region's climate is ideal for salt production, with nearly eight months of sunshine every year. The salt harvesting process takes seven to 10 days, resulting in large rock salt that can be used for fish fermentation or other purposes. Visitors can meet and talk to Mr Hon, one of the farm owners, who can provide insight into local salt farming.

Thai An Village Cycling Trip

Recommended for children aged 12 and above and for guests with a basic level of fitness. Tour departs at 6.30am. Advance 24-hour booking is required.

Setting off in the early morning, our Thai An cycling tour eases you into the day. The route passes traditional vineyards tracing the coast, with pitstops at morning markets and local cafes for a refreshing lime juice or iced ginger tea. Lasting between 60-90 minutes, at the end of your cycle our driver awaits with cold towels, ready to bring you back to Amanoï.

Nha Trang & Po Nagar Temple Day Trip

Approximately eight to ten hours.

Driving north towards Cam Ranh Airport, this full-day tour stops at Po Nagar Temple, before continuing to the Mountain Church. An optional lunch of local and international cuisine follows, concluding with an opportunity to shop and explore local night markets, which open every day from 4pm.

Visit Vinh Hy Fishing Village

The sleepy fishing village of Vinh Hy is located on the edge of Nui Chua National Park. Most of the families living here have been fishing for generations. The town is very quiet during the day because the fishermen venture out to sea late in the afternoon, seek their catch throughout the night, return to the bay at dawn and sleep most of the day.





Culinary Experiences

Cliff Pool

Under a star-lit evening sky, the Cliff Pool offers an unforgettable setting for a private dining experience. Complementing the romantic ambience is a choice of gourmet menus, including Vietnamese and barbecue.

Beachside Barbecue

Enjoy a romantic candlelit dinner for two in a secluded beachside spot overlooking Vinh Hy Bay. Our culinary team will confirm your choice of menu with you ahead of time, and a personal attendant will be on hand to assist you with any special requests on the evening.

Lotus Lake

The Lotus Lake Pavilion is the ideal setting for a secluded meal. Once food has been served, diners are left in peace and privacy to enjoy each other's company and the tranquil surrounds.

Bohemian Beachside Barbecue Setup

The Bohemian Beachside Barbecue is offered as an optional setup style. Maximum 10 persons. Please note that menu prices are not included in this fee. A minimum of 12 hours' notice for cancellations is required. Cancellations made within 12 hours will be subject to the full cost of the experience booked.

Rock Studio

Encircled by nature, the glass-fronted Rock Studio boasts spectacular views. Large, russet-hued boulders and tangled tree roots create an unforgettable foreground for your special dining experience as you step out to the wooden deck to take in magnificent Vinh Hy Bay.

Vietnamese Cooking Class

Maximum six persons.
Advance booking is required.

Introducing you to the food culture of Vietnam, this laidback cooking class provides you with a strong foundation to build upon once you have returned home. Book a private lesson and choose three dishes from our menu to master. Popular recipes include phở bò – Vietnamese beef noodle soup – and gỏi cuốn – Vietnamese fresh rice paper rolls with shrimp and pork. Following the cooking class, enjoy the fruits of your labour with a sit-down meal.

The Taste of Phan Rang

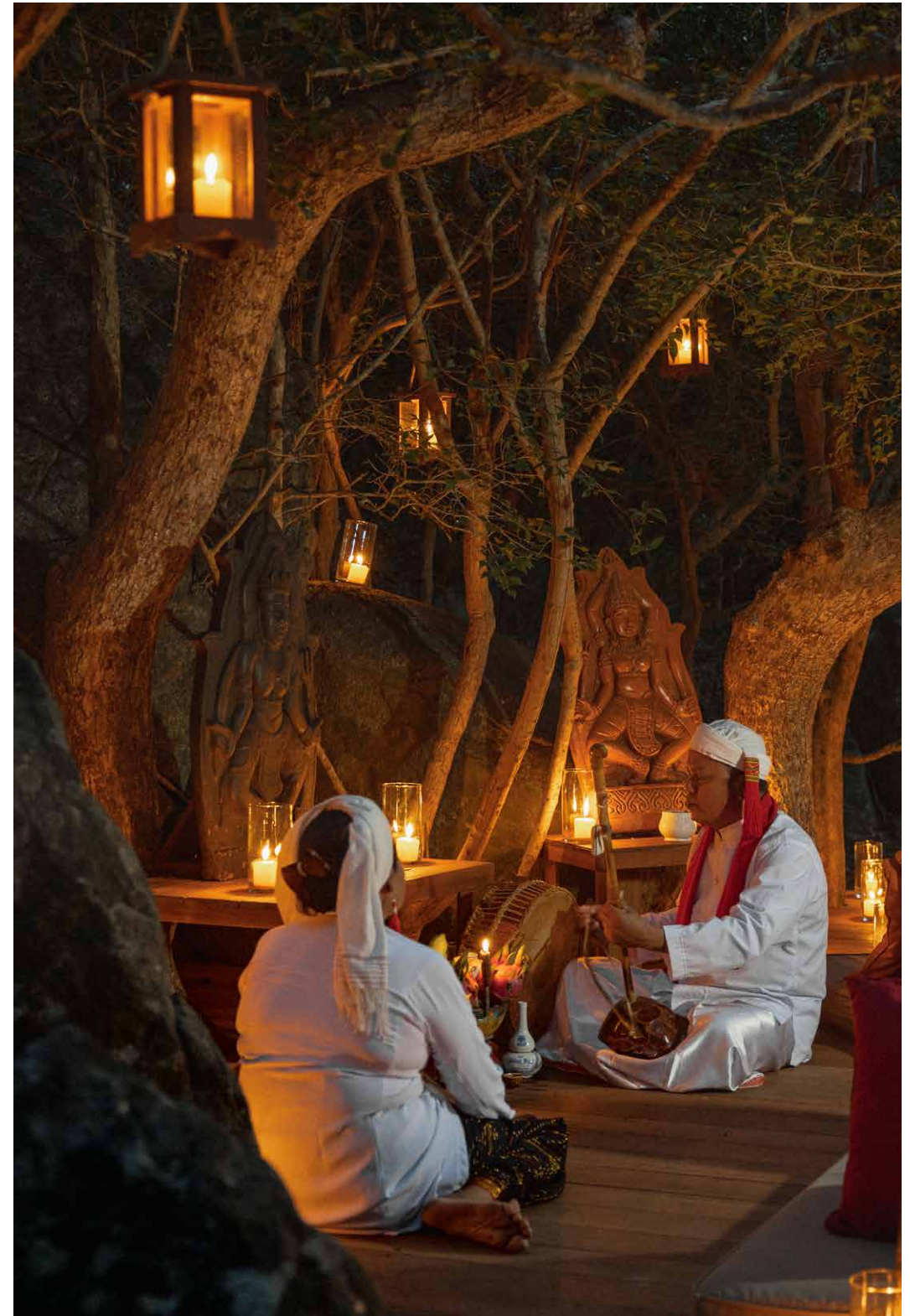
Duration: four-five hours.
Can be customised according to guests' preferences.
Vegetarian options are available.

Departing in late afternoon, venture 45 minutes south of Amani, passing picturesque beaches, villages, seasalt farms and manicured plots of onions, garlic and coriander en route to your destination. With the East Sea on one side and the mountains of the Central Highlands on the other, catch the end-of-day action at Phan Rang's Market to explore the city's street food. Each region of Vietnam offers its own variation of these national favourites; the Bánh xèo, Bánh canh, for example, is typical of Phan Rang.

Sacred Cham Dining Experience

Maximum six persons.
Advance 24-hour booking is required.

During the Sacred Cham Dining Experience a menu of carefully selected, authentic Cham dishes, such as cucumber salad with marinated octopus and pumpkin custard, are presented. Following your six-course meal, diners are invited on a gentle walk leading them to a majestic spot hidden amidst the trees. Here, an auspicious blessing ceremony is carried out by a Cham master, considered to be the most respected people in Cham culture.





Vinh Hy Awakening

Maximum five persons.
Advance 24-hour booking is required.
Weather permitting.

Start your morning like a local with a traditional breakfast at a charming restaurant in Vinh Hy Village. Guests may reach the village on foot or by a short five-minute car ride from the resort. After breakfast, take a leisurely stroll through the streets of the fishing village, where coastal scenes of the harbour and colourful stilt houses paint a charming picture. Then, embark on a scenic boat ride to explore the beauty of Vinh Hy Bay before returning to the sandy shores of Amanoi's Beach Club.

In-Villa/In-Residence Private Dining

Choice of menu available.

Enjoy a private in-villa or in-residence dining experience on the terrace of your home at Amanoi. A member of our Culinary team will prepare a bespoke menu created especially for the occasion.

Dinner at Ba Hai's House

Maximum six persons.
Advance 24-hour booking is required.

Dine at Ba Hai's house in the village of Thai An. Just a ten-minute drive from Amanoi, this charming coastal home offers a warm, authentic setting for hosted, family-style Vietnamese dinners. Ba Hai, now in her seventies, lives with her husband in the village and lovingly tends to the home that once belonged to her late mother. A former farmer, she is deeply rooted in the rhythms of village life and enjoys welcoming guests with quiet hospitality. Rising early, guests are requested to reserve an early dinnertime at Ba Hai's house to leave the family to sleep in peace by 10pm.

Twilight Cliff Lounge Experience

Maximum four persons.

Weather permitting. Sensible shoes recommended.

Take a sunset boat ride across the bay to reach a secluded stretch of coastline. Amanoï's intimate Twilight Cliff Lounge is the ideal viewpoint to watch the sun descend behind the mountain ranges of Nui Chua National Park, as a rose-hued glow is cast over the resort and hinterland beyond. A feast of Champagne and caviar sees the excursion end on a high note.

Champagne Brunch

From 11am to 2pm.

Maximum four persons. Weather permitting.

Set on Amanoï's pristine private beach, punctuate the day with a Champagne Brunch enjoyed amidst fresh ocean air. Savour perfectly chilled Champagne, taking in painterly views as waves wash against the shore.

Beach Lunch Picnic

Weather permitting.

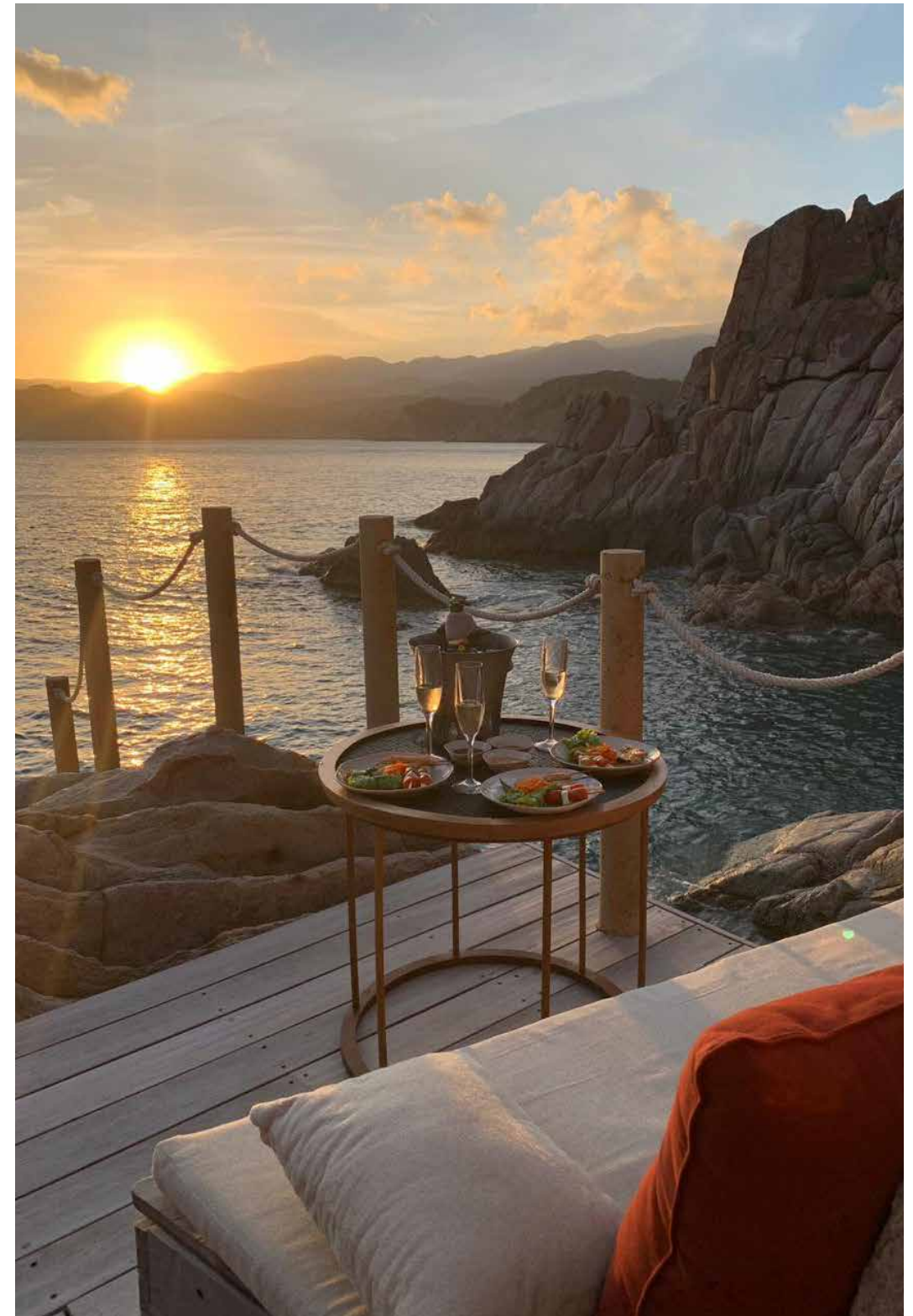
Enjoy a picnic lunch on a secluded beach, a private piece of paradise just 10 minutes from the Central Pavilion.

Art Experiences

Painting Class

The private session is approximately two hours.

Set amid nature, Amanoï is rife with creative inspiration. This painting session can take place in a variety of scenic locations across the property, and is led by a local art teacher. Guided through the basic principles of painting, from how to mix colours to the application of different techniques, at the end of your session you will have created a memorable souvenir.

Cham Pottery Making Class

Approximately two hours.

The Cham people in Ninh Thuan (now Khanh Hoa) are known for their pottery-making skills, a tradition that has been upheld for centuries. Bau Truc, a village located 10 kilometres south of Phan Rang, brings together local artisans to preserve and advance the traditional techniques passed down through generations. Every stage of creating a clay product is done by hand, with artisans moulding and shaping the pottery by revolving around it, instead of using a turntable. This results in each product having its own unique features. Pottery is baked using the heat from burnt rice husks and straw.

During pottery workshops at Amanoï, guests meet with a local artisan and learn how to make pottery the Cham way, using authentic techniques and processes. Please allow approximately three days to receive your final creation, allowing for the drying and baking of the pottery.
