Cohiba

Cohiba is the flagship brand for Habanos. The name is an ancient Taino Indian word for the bunches of tobacco leaves that Columbus first saw being smoked by the original inhabitants of Cuba - the earliest known form of a Habano. The brand was created in 1966 for the Cuban president Fidel Castro and since 1982 has been available in limited quantities to the public.

Simon Bolivar was one of the great figures of the 19th century, who liberated much of South America from Spanish rule. The brand was created in 1902 and with no surprise, a brand named after such a powerful figure is blended to match his might.

Hoyo De Monterrey

Hoyo de Monterrey owes its origin to the small town of San Juan y Martinez, right in the heart of the premium tobacco growing region of 'Vuelta Abajo' in Pinar del Río, Cuba. The brand was created by José Gener in 1865, offering a mild blend, yet very complex, suitable for every smoker.

Partagas

Created in 1845 by the Catalan Don Jaime Partagas, it is one of the oldest cigar brands. Don Jaime's ability to choose from among the best and finest tobaccos in Cuba, and an instinct for blending and fermenting tobacco, made the brand incredibly successful. Don Jaime is also legendarily credited for introducing the lectors to read and entertain the cigar rollers at the factories.

The brand was created in Cuba by brothers Ramon and Antonio Allones in 1845 and is supposedly the first cigar brand to have utilized bands on cigars, use colorful lithographs for box art and the first to package in the 8-9-8 style.

Specially Selected

Romeo y Julieta

Named after William Shakespeare's tragic lovers, the origin of Romeo y Julieta as Habanos state back to 1875. Winston Churchill became the devotee of the brand and following his visit to Havana in 1946, his name has not only been commemorated in a band, but it has also served to describe the marque's most famous size - Romeo y Julieta Churchill.

Trinidad is named after the UNESCO world heritage site, 'La Santisima Trinidad'. As a Habano brand dating back to 1969, it was originally made only for gifts to foreign diplomats; and in 1998 it was released for general sale in small quantities.

Davidoff

A brand created in 1968 by the legendary Zino Davidoff, known as the 'king of cigars'. The 1970's saw a tremendous success for the brand, as cigar shops opened to the public all over the world selling an exceptional range of premium cigars rolled out at the 'El Laguito' factory. Production of Davidoff cigars in Cuba was stopped in 1991 and the brand then started to produce cigars in the Dominican Republic.
