*The limited edition expression is the

Gin del Professore monsieur

*It is composed entirely from berries

Poli 46 Marconi

*Gin is created from an infusion of juniper
berries, Muscat grape, mountain pine,
cembra pine, mint, cardamom and
coriander. These botanicals are
reminiscent of the Asiago Plateau in the
north of the Veneto region*

Roby Marton Gin

*It is a 'handmade' gin, marketed without
being filtered or clarified, each bottle is a
unique piece, using ginger and liquorice.
Perfect as a gin & tonic or straight up*

Sylvius

*Sylvius gin is named for the doctor
Franciscus la Boe Sylvius who in 1650
first registered the name "genievre" in
pursuit of medicinals. Intensive and
floreale spirit*

Monkey 47

*It could be considered the most
complicated gin, this is a robust and
powerful gin with plenty of spice, fruit
and herb flavors: 47 ingredients*
