
Cycling tour





Aman Spa

Bali and Indonesia are rich with tradition, and the commitment to this tradition penetrates all areas of daily life. Caring for the body reflects caring for the soul, so it comes as no surprise that many rituals of self-care at the Spa are practiced in keeping with more spiritual beliefs. At Amankila, customary treatments are showcased so that you may not only experience the long-established practices of the Balinese, but so that you may also reap the benefits of such rituals.





Featured Spa Treatments

Asuci Angga

150 minutes

Inspired by the purification rituals of Bali, this treatment will leave you feeling cleansed and refreshed from head to toe.

It starts with a harmonising tamarind and lime crystal salt and fresh lime foot scrub, followed by an Amankila massage to relax your body. Then a traditional Balinese scrub made from rice powder, ginger and fresh yoghurt is applied to exfoliate the skin and stimulate the circulatory system. This is then followed by a body wrap using red ginger and cajeput to draw out toxins. Whilst cocooned in the wrap, coconut cream is massaged into your scalp to nourish your hair and calm the mind.

After showering, a moisturiser is applied to complete the Asuci Angga treatment.





Featured Spa Treatments

Cinta

150 minutes

Unwind and be present to connect and receive. Cinta translates to 'love', and this treatment is an ode to self-love and self-care.

Begin your journey with a full body rose, rice powder and yoghurt exfoliation to cleanse and purify the body. Then allow yourself to melt into a warm bath, with rose and flower essences providing an aromatic delight, opening the heart chakra and preparing you to receive a Frangipani aromatherapy massage.

The aromatherapy full body massage opens the meridians, leaving you with a complete sense of harmony.

Mandi Lulur

120 minutes

This ritual is revered for its immediate benefit to the skin and calming of the mind; it is traditionally performed as preparation for a bride on her wedding day. The treatment begins with an exfoliating body scrub using turmeric, sandalwood and ginger root. Turmeric is known for reducing skin pigmentation, Sandalwood reduces blemishes and ginger root makes the skin radiant.

A soothing application of yoghurt is then applied to the skin leaving it soft, supple and rebalanced. This is then followed by a flower filled bath to luxuriate in and reconnect with the present moment, during which a cream moisturiser is massaged gently into your scalp to nourish the hair and scalp. The treatment is completed with a 60-minute Amankila massage.
