Accommodation - Amangiri Resort

All suites are both air-conditioned for summer and feature under floor heating for the cooler winter months. Entry to each suite is via a private courtyard. A glass wall with a central door opens to a combined bedroom and living room with concertina glass doors opening from the seating area to a spacious desert lounge that frames the view of the natural landscape beyond.

The Mesa View and Private Canyon Pavilions offer spectacular views of the surrounding mesas and reverse sunset.

The One-Bedroom Private Canyon Pavilion also enjoys consummate privacy, nestled within the sandstone walls of the canyon.

The Sunset View Pavilions enjoy open-ended views of the desert dunes and rock formations.

The Grand View Pavilion boasts 360° panoramic views of the surrounding natural landscape.

The Fireside Pavilion is a cozy open-air resort venue, ideal for cocktail parties or intimate receptions with a large central fireplace located adjacent to the main swimming pool. By nightfall, the pavilion is starlit with clear skies above providing a unique atmosphere in the heart of the Utah desert.

The word Chinle in Navajo means “the canyon where water flows.” Located a short drive, hike or horse ride from the resort, the Chinle Site offers a natural desert setting surrounded by towering canyons. Here, guests can enjoy an elevated BBQ-style menu along with Navajo storytelling and music.




Saddle Landing

Located in the main pavilion, the Restaurant serves a daily changing menu of wilderness-inspired cuisine for breakfast, lunch and dinner from its open kitchen, as well as snacks and afternoon tea. Fresh Utah-sourced produce and locally raised meats are used to create rustic-but-refined rotisserie and fire-pit dishes, as well as an extensive array of vegetarian and vegan options.

A short hike or ride from Camp Sarika's main pavilion, the Raven's Nest is a private venue nestled within the Entrada sandstone, overlooking Amangiri and Camp Sarika's desert surroundings.

Located across Camp Sarika's Main Pavilion, the Amphitheater is a natural rock alcove sitting at the bottom of a 600-foot high mesa offering a uniquely intimate space for pre-dinner cocktails.





To Say 'I Do'

To get legally married in Utah, you need to apply for a marriage license and have the marriage solemnized. Marriage licenses can be obtained from the Kane County Clerk's office in Kanab, UT. Both parties must be present at the time of application. Amangiri can arrange for private transportation to and from Kanab to obtain the marriage license.



Exclusive Use of Amangiri & Camp Sarika

With its limited number of rooms and intuitive, personalized service, Amangiri provides the perfect opportunity for its guests to reserve part of or the entirety of the property as a unique venue for a special occasion. Any inquiry of five rooms or more will qualify as a group booking with a 3-night minimum stay requirement. Any booking of 15 rooms or more will be considered as a buy-out with the exclusive use of both Amangiri & Camp Sarika and a maximum capacity of 110 guests.

Camp Sarika can also be offered on an exclusive basis with a maximum capacity of 30 guests.

Amangiri Adventures

Thousands of square miles of untouched desert scenery surround Amangiri, offering a unique opportunity for outdoor adventures from hiking and climbing to scenic flights, boating on Lake Powell and horseback riding. Whether touring by air, car or on foot, Amangiri guests have access to expert in-house and local guides offering custom itineraries.

Amangiri also features an ever-expanding collection of cultural experiences for guests eager to learn more about the ecology, geology and human history of the area as well as the rich traditions of neighboring Native American tribes.

Invented centuries ago in the Italian Alps, a Via Ferrata ('iron road') is a series of cables and ladder rungs, fixed to the rock face to enable the ascent of steep mountain routes. The climbs and drops can be an adrenaline ride, but Via Ferratas also offer an opportunity to get up close to the fascinating geology of the terrain. Amangiri offers a number of fun and challenging Via Ferrata hikes led by expert guides on the property's 242 hectares.



Amangiri Spa

The Amangiri Spa is a destination in its own right, with a Water Pavilion offering hydrotherapy and floatation sessions, a watsu pool, a finishing salon, a yoga studio, a gym and indoor and outdoor treatment suites. Guests are also invited to enjoy Aman's extensive wellness menu at Camp Sarika's tranquil Spa suites, whether preparing for a special occasion, or retreating after a day's celebrations.

Day 1

Arrival

On arrival, guests are invited to check-in, and make home in the raw beauty of the resort's setting. Welcome gifts await in each suite, where relaxation time precedes arrival cocktails and a family-style dinner menu at the Fireside Pavilion, curated by Amangiri's Executive Chef.

By nightfall, the spectacular desert creates the backdrop for s'mores served around a traditional campfire – an idyllic end to your first day at Amangiri.

Experience Local Culture

A hearty breakfast starts the day, with the choice of peaceful in-room dining, or as a group at the Pool Terrace. A wellness experience follows, with a South Bath in the nearby natural amphitheater, offering a truly rejuvenating experience.

Later, take to one of the resort's many Via Ferrata's, where an exhilarating climb rewards you with dramatic vistas. Lunch can be enjoyed at leisure before the excitement of an afternoon ceremony rehearsal, followed by cocktails and canapes.

As day turns to dusk, the preparations continue with a Rehearsal Dinner at the Chinle Site. Served family style, dinner is followed by Native American Hoop Dancing where the dazzling charm and energy of traditional hoop dance, in which performers create various figures with their hoops, offers an insight into Navajo culture.

The Wedding

The day of the wedding begins with a hearty breakfast at leisure served in a choice of locations including in-room, at the Main Pavilion, or on the Pool Terrace. On this peaceful morning of preparation, guests are invited to enjoy the resort's expansive pool area and spa facilities; an opportunity to reflect and reset ahead of the big event.

Mid-afternoon, enjoy a crisp glass of pre-ceremony champagne on the Pool Terrace before the wedding ceremony begins at the Desert Lounge - with the Utah desert serving as a breathtaking backdrop for this once-in-a-lifetime occasion.

A celebratory Cocktail and Canapé Hour follows with a bespoke dinner curated by the Executive Chef, and dancing leading late into the night. To keep the party going, a late-night food station offers a range of indulgent treats - the perfect end to a magical day.
