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Welcome to Amangiri

An otherworldly desert retreat, Amangiri is situated on 920 pristine acres in Canyon Point, Southern Utah with sweeping views towards Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument. Located in the center of the Grand Circle, the all-season resort, its landmark Aman Spa and its secluded satellite camp, Camp Sarika, are surrounded by iconic natural sites, such as Grand Canyon National Park, Bryce Canyon National Park, Zion National Park and Monument Valley. It is also a short drive from the shores of Lake Powell.



Venues

Ideal for multi-day celebrations with personalized activities in between, Amangiri offers a host of venues with both indoor and alfresco settings. Ranging from the spectacular Desert Lounge at the resort to Camp Sarika's Dining Pavilion, there is a venue to suit every occasion—whether a pre-wedding welcome barbecue, a sunset ceremony, or a glamourous reception beneath the stars.



Resort Dining Room

Up to 76 guests seated 100 guests standing

Open for leisurely breakfasts, celebratory lunches, and unforgettable dinners with family and friends, the Dining Room serves American Southwest-inspired cuisine with global accents and offering breathtaking desert views. Looking out across the sand dunes and mesas through floor-to-ceiling windows or towards the resort's iconic swimming pool, the Dining Room centers around an open-plan kitchen and wood-fired oven.



Fireside Pavilion

Up to 25 guests seated 40 guests standing

Tucked under the 165-million-year-old sandstone mesa around which the resort is built, the Fireside Pavilion is a cozy open-air venue located adjacent to the main swimming pool. Ideal for cocktail parties and intimate receptions, it features a large central fireplace. At night, Utah's clear night skies form a star-strewn canopy above.



Pool Terrace

Up to 30 guests seated 40 guests standing

The terrace surrounding Amangiri's iconic pool offers a dramatic setting for a celebratory dinner. Tables can be set on the lounging terrace, whilst the daybed areas appear to be floating on water.



Desert Lounge

Up to 60 guests seated 100 guests standing

A contemporary, open-air venue with exceptional views of the desert and its fringing mesas, the Desert Lounge is ideal for cocktail parties and receptions. It is also the perfect location to gaze at Amangiri's stunning reverse sunsets and to enjoy a nightcap beneath the stars after dinner – perhaps with a local dance performance and some fireside storytelling.



Dinner on the Rocks

Up to 4 guests seated

This secluded nook nestled in the sandstone wall is the perfect setting for an intimate celebration. Easily accessible, with architectural views of the Spa, it is the ideal outpost for an alfresco dinner under the stars.



Camp Sarika Dining Room & Patio

Up to 30 guests seated 40 guests standing

Camp Sarika's Dining Room flows seamlessly onto an open-air patio with breathtaking views of the surrounding mesas. Floor-to-ceiling glass doors and sunken firepits add an elemental atmosphere to this versatile venue, while the changing menu of wilderness-inspired cuisine features fresh Utah-sourced produce, locally raised meats, rustic-but-refined rotisserie and fire-pit dishes, and an extensive array of vegetarian and vegan options.



Camp Sarika Pool Terrace

Up to 30 guests seated 40 guests standing

Splendid buttes and mesas in a shifting palette of greys, pinks and oranges cradle the main pool at Camp Sarika, offering the perfect backdrop for an open-air dinner.



Raven's Nest

Up to 30 guests seated 40 guests standing

A short hike or drive from Camp Sarika's Main Pavilion, the Raven's Nest is an intimate venue nestled within the Entrada sandstone. Overlooking the resort and Camp Sarika's desert surroundings, it is the perfect spot to enjoy a casual open-air dinner followed by dessert s'mores and storytelling around a campfire.



Amphitheater

30 guests standing

Located across from Camp Sarika's Main Pavilion, the Amphitheater is a natural rock alcove sitting at the bottom of a 600-foot mesa and offering a uniquely secluded space for pre-dinner cocktails.



Saddle Landing

100 guests standing

Saddle Landing is a remote venue on the property offering panoramic views of Navajo Mountain, Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument and Lake Powell. A short drive away from the resort, it can be set up for intimate ceremonies and larger cocktail parties.




Ceremonies

The striking architecture and raw beauty of Amangiri means that almost every turn reveals yet another location suitable for the exchanging or renewing of vows.

Ceremonies can be held at our Desert Lounge for stunning views of the surrounding mesas, especially at sunset, or in more remote areas of the property such as the Sunset Trail or the Amphitheater.





Activities & Relaxation

Serving as a springboard for exploration of the area, Amangiri offers private hiking trails, canyoneering, Via Ferrata routes, boating, hot air ballooning, horseback riding and many other activities. Fireside storytelling and stargazing in the evenings enable a deeper immersion in Native American culture, while expert archaeologists and palaeontologists share the region's history. Exclusive adventures can be arranged to complement a celebratory stay.

Guests seeking relaxation and tranquillity before or after the excitement of celebrations can retreat to Amangiri's 25,000 square-foot Spa, which offers an extensive menu of massages, beauty treatments, and restorative therapies.



Amangiri Adventures

Thousands of square miles of untouched desert landscape surround Amangiri, offering an exclusive opportunity for outdoor adventures from hiking and climbing to scenic flights, boating on Lake Powell, and horseback riding. Whether touring by air, car or on foot, Amangiri guests have access to expert in-house and local guides offering custom itineraries.

Amangiri also features an ever-expanding collection of cultural experiences for guests eager to learn more about the ecology, geology, and human history of the area, as well as the rich traditions of neighboring Native American tribes.

Via Ferrata

Invented centuries ago in the Italian Alps, a Via Ferrata ('iron path') is a series of cables and ladder rungs fixed to a rock face to enable the ascent of steep mountain routes. Amangiri offers an extensive Via Ferrata network with seven guided routes. Each climbs around 400 feet through the otherworldly landscape offering breathtaking views. Several of the routes connect to the Cave Peak Stairway, a 120-step, ladder-style suspension bridge.



Amangiri Spa

The Amangiri Spa is a destination in its own right where guests find tranquillity and stillness in a range of dedicated wellness spaces. These include the Water Pavilion, indoor and outdoor treatment rooms, the yoga studio, finishing salon, and fitness centre. Guests are also invited to enjoy Aman's extensive wellness menu at Camp Sarika's Spa suites, whether preparing for a special occasion, or retreating after a day's celebrations.

Amangiri's expert therapists offer signature treatments and journeys drawing on the elements of earth, wind, fire, and water.



Dining

Spirit of The Journey Menu

Drawing inspiration from the culinary traditions of the Southwestern and American Indian communities, the Spirit of the Journey Menu celebrates the region's rich cultural heritage.

Navajo: Native fried bread, juniper braised bison, nopal cactus, sundried tomato aioli

Or

Pima: Tamale, sedona wild mushroom, heritage tepary beans, high desert squash, salsa fresca, chili verde

Maricopa: Uinta valley honey glazed duck, wild roquette, compressed plum, toasted almond, sour cherry vinaigrette

Paiute: Sage roasted Colorado River rainbow trout, wild rice pilaf, smoked trout caviar, chili rojo

Or

Apache: Woodfire elk tenderloin, ancho pepper demi-glace, blue corn polenta, coal-roasted heirloom roots

Hopi: Arizona corn crèmeux, sumac berry confit a la "chillchin", corn veil, corn crumble



Sample Itinerary

Though every experience at Amangiri is highly personalized, the following sample itinerary includes all of the must-do activities across a three-night stay. Whether seeking desert adventure or a wellness retreat, there's something for every guest to enjoy. Days 1 & 2

Day 1 Arrival

On arrival, guests are invited to check-in, then settle into their suites amid the raw beauty of the resort's setting. Welcome gifts await in each suite, where relaxation time precedes arrival cocktails and a family-style dinner menu at the Fireside Pavilion, curated by Amangiri's Executive Chef.

By nightfall, the spectacular desert creates the backdrop for s'mores served around a traditional campfire – an idyllic end to your first day at Amangiri. Day 2

Experience Local Culture

A hearty breakfast starts the day, either in your suite's peaceful embrace or together on the Pool Terrace. A wellness experience follows, with a Sound Bath in the nearby natural amphitheater offering tranquil rejuvenation.

Later, take to one of the resort's many Via Ferratas, where an exhilarating climb rewards you with dramatic views. Lunch can be enjoyed at leisure before the excitement of an afternoon ceremony rehearsal, followed by cocktails and canapés.

As day turns to dusk, the preparations continue with a Rehearsal Dinner in the Main Pavilion. Served family-style, dinner is followed by Native American Hoop Dancing in which performers create various figures and tell communal stories with their hoops. This experience offers a unique insight into Navajo culture.

The Wedding

The day of the wedding begins with a hearty breakfast at leisure, served in a choice of locations including in-suite, at the Main Pavilion, or on the Pool Terrace.

On this peaceful morning of preparation, guests are invited to enjoy the resort's expansive pool area and spa facilities; an opportunity to reflect and reset ahead of the special event.

Mid-afternoon, enjoy a crisp glass of pre-ceremony champagne on the Pool Terrace before the wedding ceremony begins. Held at the Desert Lounge, the Utah desert serves as a breathtaking backdrop to this once-in-a-lifetime occasion.

Celebratory cocktails and canapés follow, then a bespoke dinner curated by Amangiri's Executive Chef and dancing late into the night. To keep the party going, a latenight food station offers a range of indulgent treats – the perfect end to a magical day. Day 4 Departure

With its limited number of rooms and intuitive, personalized service, Amangiri provides the perfect opportunity for its guests to reserve part of or the entire property as a unique venue for a special occasion. Any booking of 15 rooms or more will be considered a buy-out with the exclusive use of both the Resort and Camp Sarika and a maximum capacity of 100 guests.

Camp Sarika can also be offered on an exclusive basis with a maximum capacity of 30 guests.

Accommodation

The resort's 34 suites are situated in two elegant wings that sweep from each side of its Main Pavilion. Claiming panoramic desert or mesa views through floor to ceiling glass doors, all suites offer private terraces, fireplaces, king-size beds, and private courtyard entrances.

Adding 10 luxurious one- and two-bedroom Pavilions to the accommodation offering, Camp Sarika lies a five-minute drive or a picturesque 30-minute walk from the resort. Continuing the clean lines and natural aesthetic of the resort, the camp's Pavilions each have spacious sleeping and living areas, as well as expansive terraces with fire pits and heated plunge pools.

All suites are air-conditioned for summer and feature underfloor heating for the cooler winter months. Entry to each suite is via a private courtyard. A glass wall with a central door opens to a combined bedroom and living room with concertina glass doors opening from the seating area to a spacious desert lounge that frames the view of the natural landscape beyond.

All pavilions are air-conditioned for summer and feature underfloor heating for the cooler winter months. They boast a large terrace and outdoor living area with fire pit, private heated plunge pool, and a king-size bed or twins as needed. Guests at Camp Sarika have unrestricted access to all facilities and features of the resort.

The Mesa View and Private Canyon Pavilions offer spectacular views of the surrounding mesas and reverse sunset.

The One-Bedroom Private Canyon Pavilion also enjoys consummate privacy, nestled within the sandstone walls of the canyon.

The Sunset View Pavilions enjoy open-ended views of the desert dunes and rock formations.

The Grand View Pavilion boasts 360° panoramic views of the surrounding natural landscape.
