

Amangani

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Situated close to some of the USA's finest ski slopes, as well as Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks, Amangani (peaceful home) is an all-season resort overlooking the beautiful valley of Jackson Hole. Perched on the crest of East Gros Ventre Butte, the property affords magnificent views of the Grand Tetons and Snake River Valley. Evoking the atmosphere of the American West, Amangani presents 40 Suites, a free-standing Home, a spa, an outdoor heated pool with Teton views, and a ski lounge.

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Situated close to some of the USA's finest ski slopes, as well as Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks, Amangani (peaceful home) is an all-season resort overlooking the beautiful valley of Jackson Hole. Perched on the crest of East Gros Ventre Butte, some 2,135 metres above sea level, the property affords magnificent views of the Grand Tetons and Snake River Valley. The first Aman resort in North America, it evokes the atmosphere of the American West, from its redwood panelling to its blazing log fires. Amangani presents 40 Suites, a free-standing Home, a spa, an outdoor heated pool and a ski lounge.

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High above Jackson Hole in Wyoming, Amangani (peaceful home) is perched on the crest of East Gros Ventre Butte. This lofty retreat is a year-round destination, acting as a premier ski resort from late November through early April with a private ski lounge at the foot of Rendezvous Mountain. Minutes from Grand Teton National Park and 100 kilometres (62 miles) from Yellowstone National Park, the resort is also an ideal base for exploring nature in the warmer months when hiking, mountain biking, wildlife viewing and fly fishing are popular attractions.

Amangani offers 40 Suites of varying sizes, all with magnificent mountain and valley views. Suites include a bedroom/living room, a bathroom/dressing room, and a private deck or balcony. A deep soaking tub with mountain views is central to each Suite's bathroom. The free-standing Amangani Home also enjoys full access to the resort's award-winning facilities and offers four en-suite bedrooms.

From Amangani's entrance, a sweep of steps leads down to the Lounge with its double-height windows, soaring redwood ceiling and two wood-burning fireplaces. The resort's main dining venue is The Grill, a 65-seat dining room with mountain views, specialising in local, sustainable ranch meats, fresh fish and seasonal farm-to-table produce. The Zinc Bar provides intimate, window-side pairings of tables and chairs and access to a terrace overlooking the pool.

Enjoying panoramic mountain views, Amangani's 35-metre (115-foot) heated outdoor swimming pool is linked to an expansive whirlpool. With a winter water temperature of 27°C (80°F), both can be enjoyed year-round.

Amangani's Spa and Fitness Centre features two exercise studios, which overlook the pool and the Snake River Range beyond, as well as four treatment rooms, a finishing salon and separate steam rooms for men and women.

Other facilities include the Library; the Takoda Room, a relaxed venue for meetings, private dinners and events; and a boutique known as the Gallery.

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High above Jackson Hole in Wyoming, Amangani (peaceful home) is perched on the crest of East Gros Ventre Butte, some 2,135 metres (7,000 feet) above sea level. This lofty retreat is a year-round destination acting as a premier ski resort from late November through early April with a private ski lounge at the foot of Rendezvous Mountain. It is also an ideal base for exploring the surrounding national parks in the warmer months when hiking, mountain biking, wildlife viewing and fly fishing are popular attractions.

Set at the southern end of this extensive alpine valley, just 20 minutes from the vast and varied ski terrain of Rendezvous and Apres Vous mountains, Amangani offers breathtaking views of the mountain ranges encircling Jackson Hole. Directly across from the three-storey resort is Teton Pass, which divides the Snake River Range from the snow-capped Tetons and their highest peak, the 4,200-metre (13,770-foot) Grand Teton. Amangani is minutes from Grand Teton National Park and just 100 kilometres (62 miles) from Yellowstone National Park.

Amangani offers 40 Suites of varying sizes, all with magnificent mountain and valley views. Suites include a bedroom/living room and a bathroom/dressing room, and provide a king-size bed, fireplace, window-side daybed, dining table and woven cowhide chairs. Sliding glass doors lead to a deck with a wrought-iron table and chairs for taking in the view. A deep soaking tub with mountain views is central to each Suite's bathroom.

Amangani also offers a Home with the same aesthetics and design features as the resort. Amangani's Home is a spacious, free-standing dwelling offering four en-suite bedrooms, daily housekeeping, private dining and full access to the resort's award-winning facilities.

From Amangani's entrance, a sweep of steps leads down to the Lounge with its double-height windows, soaring redwood ceiling and two wood-burning fireplaces. This is the ideal venue for casual afternoon and evening dining with spectacular views.

Amangani's main dining venue is The Grill, a 65-seat dining room open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. The redwood-panelled walls and ceiling, specially-commissioned artwork, wood-burning fireplace and dramatic mountain views lend a mood of stylish comfort. Specialising in local, sustainable ranch meats, fresh fish and seasonal farm-to-table produce, The Grill also offers a private dining room, and picnic lunches can be prepared with advance notice.

The Zinc Bar is defined by rugged sandstone columns and intimate, window-side pairings of tables and chairs. In the summer, drinks can be taken out onto the terrace overlooking the pool.

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Amangani's Spa and Fitness Centre features two exercise studios, four treatment rooms, a finishing salon and separate steam rooms for men and women. Both exercise studios offer views over the swimming pool and the valley to the Snake River Range beyond.

Other facilities include the Library; the Takoda Room, a relaxed venue for meetings, private dinners and events; and a boutique known as the Gallery.
