



# AMANKILA

Fact Sheet



Karangasem Regency, which sits in the shadow of the majestic and dramatic Mount Agung, is known as one of the most traditional regencies in Bali. Showcasing some of Bali's most beautiful hidden treasures.

With sacred Mount Agung as its backdrop and unimpeded views of the Lombok Strait, Amankila enjoys a breathtaking hilltop spot in the historic Karangasem Regency, on Bali's east coast.

The 31 spacious stilted suites offer exceptional views of the Lombok Strait from their hillside locations amongst frangipani and bougainvillea and are connected to the resort's facilities by elevated walkways.

#### **Locations**

- Cliffsides position overlooking the Lombok Strait in East Bali
- Near to Manggis, Candi Dasa, Tenganan, and other villages in Karangasem, Bali's most traditional regency

## Accommodation

Raised on stilts and thatched with alang-alang, Amankila's 31 suites – 12 with private pools – enjoy ocean or garden views, and consummate privacy. Decorated with inlaid pearl and coconut-shell furniture, all suites feature canopied King-size beds, a living area, a large bathroom with a soaking tub, and an outdoor terrace.

### Indrakila Suite

- Perched on the hillside
- Expansive views stretching past the temple and far along the East coast of Bali
- Private 9.2-metre pool ensconced by a paras-stone
- Lounging balé
- Outdoor terrace living area and outdoor daybed which can be covered by bamboo blinds
- Separate bathtub and shower in terrazzo finish

### Amankila Suite

- Serviced by a private butler
- 2 bedrooms open onto a large terrace
- Views of the beach and the Amuk Bay
- Ideal for guests wanting complete privacy, or for 2 couples who wish to stay together
- Private 10.5-metre pool ensconced by a paras-stone
- 2 lounging balés, each on the side of the private swimming pool
- Outdoor terrace living area and outdoor daybed which can be covered by bamboo blinds
- Separate bathtub and shower in terrazzo finish

### The Restaurant

## Experiences

Amankila is ideally placed for exploring local craft villages, the verdant countryside and the region's royal ruins. Stretching from the hilltop to the private beach, the property lies within reach of atmospheric temples and artisan villages.

### East Bali Tour

Amankila's East Bali tour takes approximately 3 hours and includes the highlights of the region. Travel in a private vehicle with a private driver.

- **Tenganan village visit**

Visit the rural villages of Tenganan, a religious community and artisan centre that produces a rare ikat textile, guests can see the making of the famous double ikat.

- **Water Palace**

Discover the magnificent water palaces of Tirtagangga and Taman Ujung in the area known as 'old Bali'. Water Palace was once an area of royalty, gaining insight into the region's regal past.

- **Samsara Living Museum**

Samsara Living Museum offers guests a myriad of immersive activities to better comprehend traditional Bali life.

### Sunrise and Sunset Cruise

Two jukung-style outriggers, Aman XII (50 ft) and Aman XIV (40 ft) are available to charter for either sunrise or sunset cruises. The sunrise cruise is also best enjoyed with pairing activities of snorkelling, to further explore east Bali's pristine reefs, and breakfast on the boat.

### Beach Sports

The Beach Club offers an array of thrilling water sports equipment and activities, including kayaks, stand-up paddle boards, and boogie boards. From beach bats to soccer, volleyball, or frisbee, our beach attendants are happy to provide the equipment and make up a team.

### Trekking

The region is ideal for trekking, taking in rural villages, tropical forests, terraced rice paddies, mountains, and temples. Amankila's guides also offer expert local knowledge of the surroundings.

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
