Welcome to Amangani

In the foothills of the Grand Tetons, near the snow-sports paradise of Jackson Hole, Amangani looks out across the mountains and plains of the Snake River Valley. Amangani or "the peaceful home" clings to the crest of East Gros Ventre Butte, some 72,135 metres above sea level, high above the town of Jackson, Wyoming. Evoking the pioneering spirit of the Old West in its redwood and sandstone architecture, this 40-suite retreat is a year-round destination acting as an ideal base for exploring the magnificent natural surroundings.



Venues

Ideal for multi-day celebrations with personalised activities, Amangani offers a host of above-and-beyond indoor and outdoor venues. Exclusive use of the resort promises your own private mountain retreat, with every detail of the event taken care of by the Amangani team. Whether a pre-wedding barbecue, a sunset ceremony or a glamorous poolside reception beneath the stars, we have a space to suit your occasion.



Lounge

Up to 65 guests seated
80 guests standing

The Lounge offers 60-foot, floor-to-ceiling windows that showcase breathtaking mountain and valley views. Two double doors open up to a spacious terrace overlooking the pool. This is a public space but can be used exclusively for buyouts and whole-hotel bookings.



The Grill

Up to 70 guests seated
80 guests standing

Terrazzo tables, metal art and a wood-burning fireplace lend a distinctive and intimate ambience to the Grill. Traditionally used as a dining area, the atmosphere is ideal for large group events and dramatic wedding dinners.



Takoda Room

40 Guests Seated
50 Guests Standing

An elegant yet relaxing setting for a private dinner or reception, the Takoda Room features redwood-paneled walls, with a word-burning fireplace and regional artwork. The room also offers a large TV screen.



Library

Enjoy breathtaking views of the mountains from comfortable rawhide and rattan seating. The Library is often used as an extension to the Takoda Room for pre-dinner cocktails, or as a satellite bar for larger events.



Pool Deck

The expansive Pool Deck runs the length of Amangani's outdoor heated infinity pool. It provides an ideal space for ceremonies and receptions with dramatic mountain and valley views



North Lawn

40 Guests Seated

Located on the north side of the property with mesmerising views of the Tetons, this undulating open-air venue is ideal for picturesque ceremonies or cocktail receptions beneath Wyoming's endless skies.



Zinc Bar & Terrace

30 Guests Seated
40 Guests Standing

Framed by rugged sandstone columns, the Zinc Bar offers a year-round gathering place, with an adjacent terrace that creates the perfect setting for an intimate ceremony or cocktail reception during warmer months.



Wapiti Lawn

10 Guests Seated

Enjoy magnificent mountain views of the Snake River Range, especially at sunset. Our Wapiti Lawn is perfect for smaller wedding gatherings, events and alfresco cocktail celebrations.



Ceremonies

Amangani's spectacular natural surroundings and unique architecture means that almost every turn reveals another setting suitable for exchanging or renewing vows. Ceremonies can be held in a number of locations, from picturesque outdoors settings overlooking Snake River or the Tetons, to the more intimate Zinc Bar & Grill.



Dining

The cuisine at Amangani is inspired by the American Southwest and made primarily from locally sourced ingredients. Our special event menus are a starting point, designed to be explored and discussed with our chefs, who are on hand to accommodate any themes or dietary restrictions. Service can take many forms from buffet and family-style to elegant French dining.

When making Amangani your own, you and your guests will enjoy the utmost privacy in one of the world's most spectacular natural settings.

Amangani offers 40 Suites of varying sizes, all with magnificent mountain and valley views. Suites include a bedroom/living room and a bathroom/dressing room, and provide a king-size bed, fireplace, window-side daybed, dining table and woven cowhide chairs. Sliding glass doors lead to a deck with a wrought-iron table and chairs for taking in the view. A deep soaking tub with mountain views is central to each Suite's bathroom.

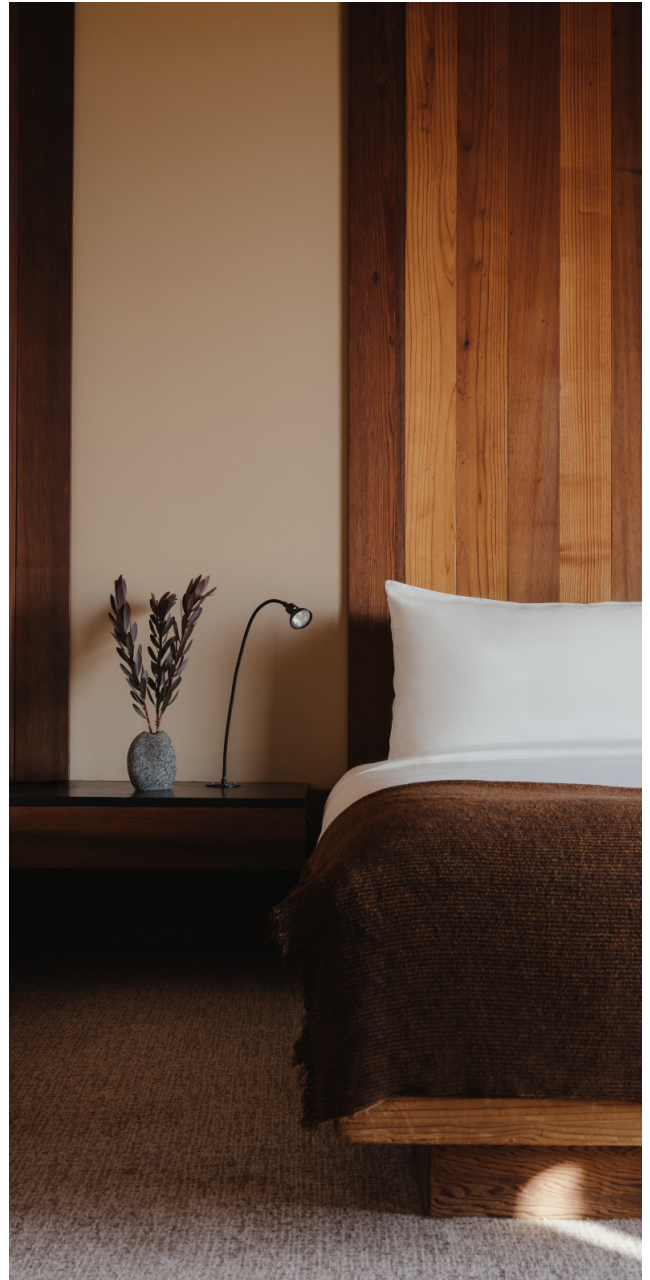


Amangani Accommodation

With high ceilings, balconies and large picture windows to frame mountain views, Amangani's Suites are warm havens that celebrate their natural setting. Wood and stone are prominent, referencing the mountains and forests, while woven cowhide chairs and faux-fur throws nod to the region's wild soul.

The resort's Homes - mountain dwellings with four to six bedrooms - further ingrate with their surroundings, offering privacy from their pitch on Amangani's hillside slopes.

Activities & Relaxation

A year-round destination, Jackson Hole is known for its snow sports in winter and multitude of outdoor activities in spring, summer and autumn. Whether heli-skiing from the highest peaks, fly fishing on the Snake River, horse riding through forests at the foothills of the Tetons or venturing into the surrounding national parks, including Grand Teton and Yellowstone, nature's splendour will inspire you, no matter the season.



Relaxation at Amangani

Amangani Spa reflects Jackson's unique mountain heritage and surrounding wilderness. Alpine-inspired treatments incorporate natural ingredients and aromas, native to the area: from mountain juniper and sage to lavender and cedar. Therapeutic treatments soothe muscles, rejuvenate skin, heighten the senses and enhance an overall feeling of health and wellness. All spa arrangements are subject to an 22% service fee.

Native Crystal Ritual

120 minutes

This holistic ritual is designed to absorb and direct energies through the healing power of crystals. Calm anxiety with the gentle application of AMAN's Grounding Amethysts Scrub, rich in Rose Damascena Oil and Amethyst Powder. An infrared, oxygenation Amethyst Eye Mask and Weighted Crystal Blanket are intended to harness natural remedial energy.

The science of this weighted blanket combined with the energy of clear quartz, rose quartz and amethyst, creates a self-care seal. A warm shower to remove the scrub prepares your body for a head-to-toe massage. The restorative vibrations from the crystal sound bath will awaken your blissful state. A cup of Valerian Root & Lemon Balm Tea follows.

Native Detox Therapy

120 minutes

This holistic ritual is designed to detox your body. Start the cleanse be a lighting of cleansing white sage. A full-body polish with a yarrow-petal scrub is followed by a bentonite-clay mud wrap to help extract toxins. A warm shower prepares your skin for a customised full-body massage. Warm towels, infused with essential oils, are applied to the hands and feet. A Wellness Detox Juice follows.





Adventures at Amangani

Horseback Riding In Jackson Hole

A number of horseback-riding adventures are available during your stay in Jackson Hole. For the beginner, a scenic ride along our East Gros Ventre Butte provides sweeping views of the majestic Tetons and the town of Jackson. More experienced riders can soak up the spirit of the Rocky Mountains on a horseback with trails through the more distant wilderness.

Amangani Signature Wildlife Tour

At Amangani, we offer in-house guided wildlife safaris, tours of Yellowstone and Grand Teton national parks, as well as hikes. Any of these activities would be the perfect start to an Amangani vacation, learning first-hand about the area while also becoming acclimated to our mountainous environment.

Enjoy a wildlife expedition through the pristine valley of Jackson Hole with an experienced guide who will introduce you to the array of wildlife in the Greater Yellowstone ecosystem. Your Concierge will be able to design your itinerary to fit your needs.

Floating In The Tetons By Hot-Air Balloon

Hot-air ballooning above the valley is an awe-inspiring start to the day. Taking off, you will discover the wonders and serenity of a hot-air balloon flight. Soaring over 1,000 feet above the valley floor in total silence, you'll enjoy 360-degree views of the Gros Ventre, Teton, Absaroka and Snake River mountain ranges from the comfort and safety of your group or private balloon basket.

Jackson Hole Mountain Resort

Located in the alpine community of Teton Village, the ski Area of Jackson Hole covers a vast range of terrain offering more than 2,500 skiable acres. Thirteen lifts, including the famous "Big Red" tram, and a high speed quad, offer unparalleled access. The combination of one of the greatest lift-serviced vertical drops in North America (4,139 feet) and an average annual snow fall of 450 inches results in some of the best skiing and snowboarding anywhere in the world. Teton Village is located 25 minutes from Amangani and offers shops, restaurants, bars and myriad recreational activities.





Getting There

Transportation

Airport valet service is available to guests from Jackson Hole Airport (JAC), Idaho Falls Regional Airport (IDA) and Salt Lake City (SLC). Travel manifests are requested two weeks prior to arrival. Transportation charges are based on your specific needs and upon receipt of travel manifest an estimate of charges will be provided.

RYL Jets can provide a wide range of global aviation options for both domestic and international flights to and from Jackson, Wyoming. Guests will have access to a wide range of aircraft and bespoke itineraries to fit their travel needs.

Getting To Jackson

The nearest airport is located at the base of the spectacular Teton mountain range. Located within Grand Teton National Park, flying into Jackson Hole Airport (JAC) is a dramatic start to your Amangani adventure, just 14 miles away. Other airports options Idaho Falls Regional Airport (IDA) and Salt Lake City (SLC). Transportation to/from Idaho Falls and Salt Lake City Airports are subject to an additional charge.
