Amangiri

Brainstorming Session

Amangiri made its debut in the fall of 2009 and has been a trailblazer in the region as a leader in experiential luxury travel. Its remote location on 900 acres of wilderness is conducive to immersing oneself in nature, escapism, and a plethora of adventures on and off property making it an experience unlike any other. Camp Sarika launched in July 2020 and was an instant success, thriving during the pandemic as a blueprint for the discerning traveler with the hallmarks of privacy, isolation, and nature. The hotel with its 34 suites remains the shining star while Camp

Sarika with 10 luxury tents has seen a recent decrease in interest, as we discussed at length.

As we continue to strive for excellence and set the bar high, the open discussion session proved to be invaluable to tap into your vast knowledge, sharing ideas on how we can improve and reposition the camp to alleviate confusion for travel advisors and guests. We have put together a list of topics and actions from our discussion to implement.

AMANGIRI RESORT

TOPIC: AMANGIRI - CONSUMER PERCEPTION

The property is highly coveted for its remote luxury experience - its exclusivity, isolated setting, natural surroundings and unique location. Nevertheless, more should be done to communicate these elements to the client and, in turn, create an understanding and attraction to travel to Amangiri.

ACTION

Amangiri will work on elevating the experience across various divisions to drive awareness of the destination and welcome all market segments, by:

- Elevating the outdoor programming experiences including Lake Powell, UTV, family activities including Dinosaur Digs, kids via Ferrata, and other child-friendly programs to drive the message that Amangiri is family friendly;
- Implementing new dining options and events including themed dinners with music and stargazing at the Desert Lounge, welcome gatherings with the General Manager and team to bring guests together and engage them at a higher level to drive repeat business and loyalty;
- Creating a calendar of events based on seasonality to drive awareness and generate interest with activities available all year round. This is to be clear on the website to show the ever-evolving calendar of activities.
- The complimentary car option for the half-day will be presented more clearly to the guests as this is a key value add for their stay.



TOPIC: AMANGIRI WEBSITE

The website’s look and feel is very engaging with its video and photography, however, some adjustments need to be made to differentiate the hotel from Camp Sarika.

ACTION

The video is to be revised to include Camp Sarika, make it a shorter version, include more activities like Lake Powell. The video is dark and the model’s attire, black, does not relate to Amangiri. The naming of Camp Sarika’s accommodation should be modified to Luxury Tents vs. Pavilions. A separate web page for Camp Sarika will be launching with the naming convention amended to ‘at Amangiri’ rather than ‘by Amangiri’ to drive a clear message.

TOPIC: WEBSITE

Highlight the destination, the property as having two seasons, much like we have for Amangani, noting the myriad of recommended activities for selected travel dates.

ACTION

The website to showcase activities based on seasonality, recommending activities for the winter season and cooler months (Nov to Mar) versus spring season to summer months (Apr – Oct).

TOPIC: AMANGIRI - CHALLENGES

It is noted by the consumer and travel trade partners that the property needs to provide a consistent level of service in all divisions to meet client’s expectations.

ACTION

Amangiri to implement a training program to elevate the service level in all divisions including reservations, concierge, experience, spa, food and beverage, and ensure the property is delivering top level client support consistently.

CAMP SARIKA AT AMANGIRI

TOPIC: CAMP SARIKA – CONSUMER PERCEPTION

The property symbolizes adventure, family and a peaceful private setting for gatherings. However, there is still a lack of understanding of the Camp vs. Hotel positioning. It feels like the ‘stepchild’ of Amangiri.

ACTION

We will rename Camp Sarika ‘at Amangiri’ instead of ‘by Amangiri’, and we will reposition it separately with its own identity and make it clearer on the website. With a higher price at Camp Sarika, the team will evaluate the inclusion of value-added features: for example:

- A dedicated guide per tent, inclusive of an activity for the family, one for the children, wildlife workshop (spider, snakes), enhanced spa experience and create packages for Camp Sarika only, targeting families and the spring break season.
- Sell it as a desert – similar to Amanjena in Morocco
- Social media will focus on activities, experiences, families.
- Operations to evaluate the option of installing lighting to showcase the grandeur of the mountains and nature at night.

TOPIC: CAMP SARIKA – CHALLENGES

The property enjoyed strong occupancy from 2020 to 2022 which also highlighted some of the areas that require improvement to deliver an exceptional consistent experience for the guests.

ACTION

We will work on elevating the spa experience to balance the spa limitations with no gym. We have noted staff limitations, and the property will work on talent recruitment and retention. By resolving the many concerns relating to service and programming, we hope it will alleviate the guests’ concerns regarding the plunge pool size and for them to focus on stronger deliverables.

TOPIC: AMANGIRI – FUTURE CONCERNS

The property is iconic due to its Aman branding, architecture/design, its stunning pool, location and low-key count. With the residential development in the next five years, the experience will be affected with multiple factors including staff for the expansion.

ACTION

The residential development will be managed very cautiously to ensure the guest experience and view is not affected or is affected to the minimum. The implementation of this project includes increasing talent recruitment and staff retention to support the expansion and avoid overwhelming Amangiri’s public spaces which belong to the hotel and Camp Sarika customers.





TOPIC: AMANGIRI COMPETITIVE SET

The property stands on its own in the US region with no direct competition, but it is important to evaluate other properties that provide similar experiences in the US or other countries to elevate Amangiri’s positioning and differentiation.

ACTION

We will observe behavior of the following properties to learn from and support the repositioning of Camp Sarika at Amangiri: Under Canvas, Moab, Clayoquet Wilderness Lodge, BC. Canada; Naviva, A Four Seasons Resort, Punta Mita, Mexico; Blackberry Fam, Walland, TN (Mountain & Farm); Singita Lodges, Africa; Four Seasons Tented Camp Thailand, Tembo Plains in Zimbabwe and Vanyavilas in India.

TOPIC: AMANGIRI PERCEIVED AS ‘ALWAYS FULL’

ACTION

The property maintains an active waitlist. Availability and need dates initially to be communicated to the Advisory Board prior to deploying to key accounts.

TOPIC: AMANGIRI IDEAL FOR CORPORATE RETREATS, AND BUYOUTS.

ACTION

Create a campaign “Face Your Fears”, Camp of your Own brochure for camp buyouts applicable to all market segments. Ideal for family gatherings, spring break at Camp Sarika, high level corporate meetings, and weddings.
