## An Unrivalled Destination

Encapsulating Shanghai's heady mix of old and new, Amanyangyun rests on the outskirts of this cosmopolitan global city—a must-visit destination in China. A destination that never sleeps, it is as famous for its dining and contemporary art scene as for its historical sites, one of the most iconic being the Bund.

Symbolic of the city's long history as a meeting point for East and West, the Bund's classical buildings overlook the Huangpu River towards the modern skyscrapers of Pudong, a thriving financial and commercial hub. Other attractions include Yuyuan Garden's two exquisitely-landscaped hectares dating back to the Ming Dynasty, the leafy lanes of the Former French Concession and the graceful pagodas and temples and Zhujiajiao Water Town.

Ideally placed to explore all that Shanghai has to offer, Amanyangyun encompasses 140 pristine hectares of forests, lawns and lakes just 26 kilometres from the centre. The resort's annual calendar includes cultural highlights for every season, waiting to be discovered.

21-23 MARCH

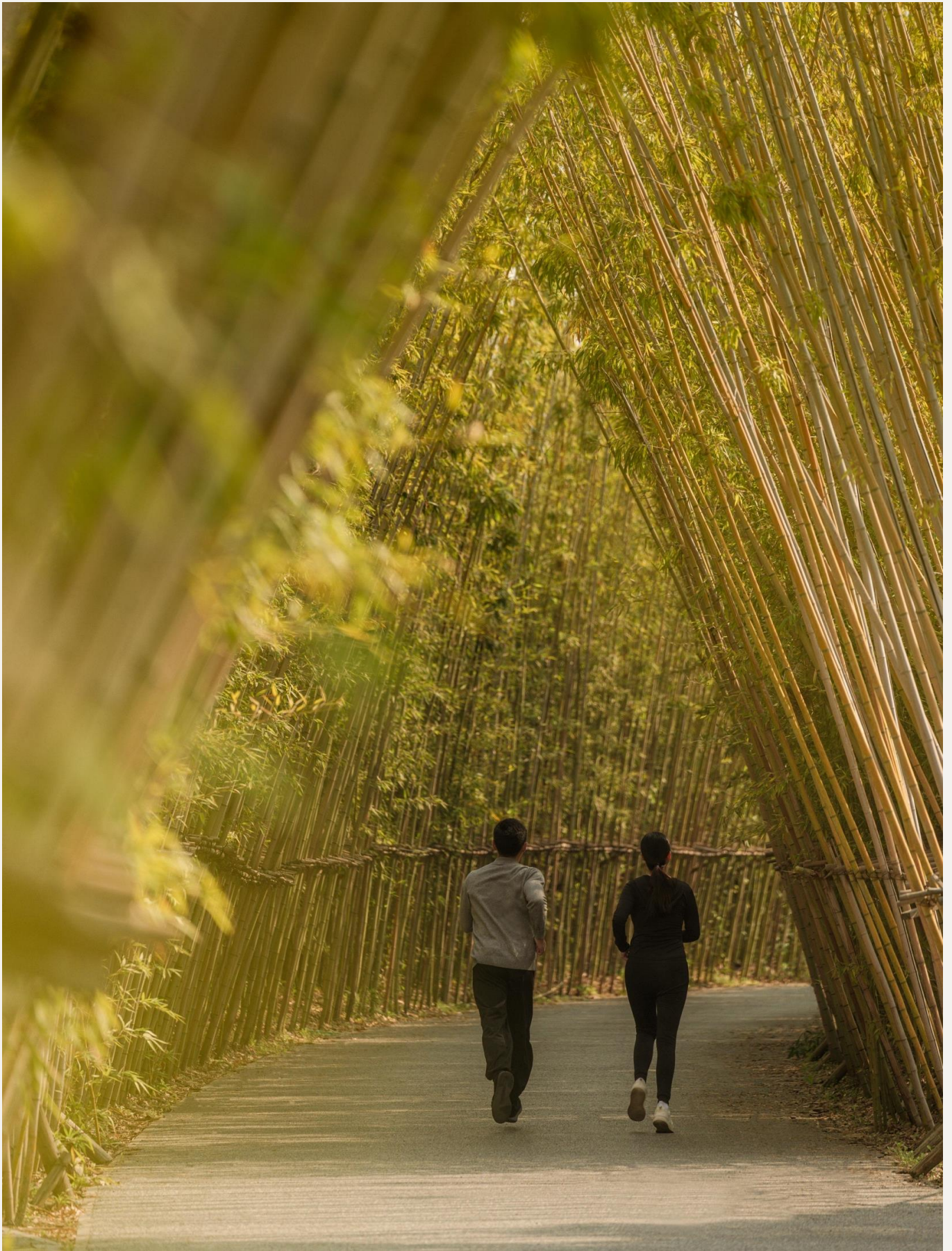
Motorsport fans will revel in the thrilling events of Chinese Grand Prix, held at the nearby Shanghai International Circuit.

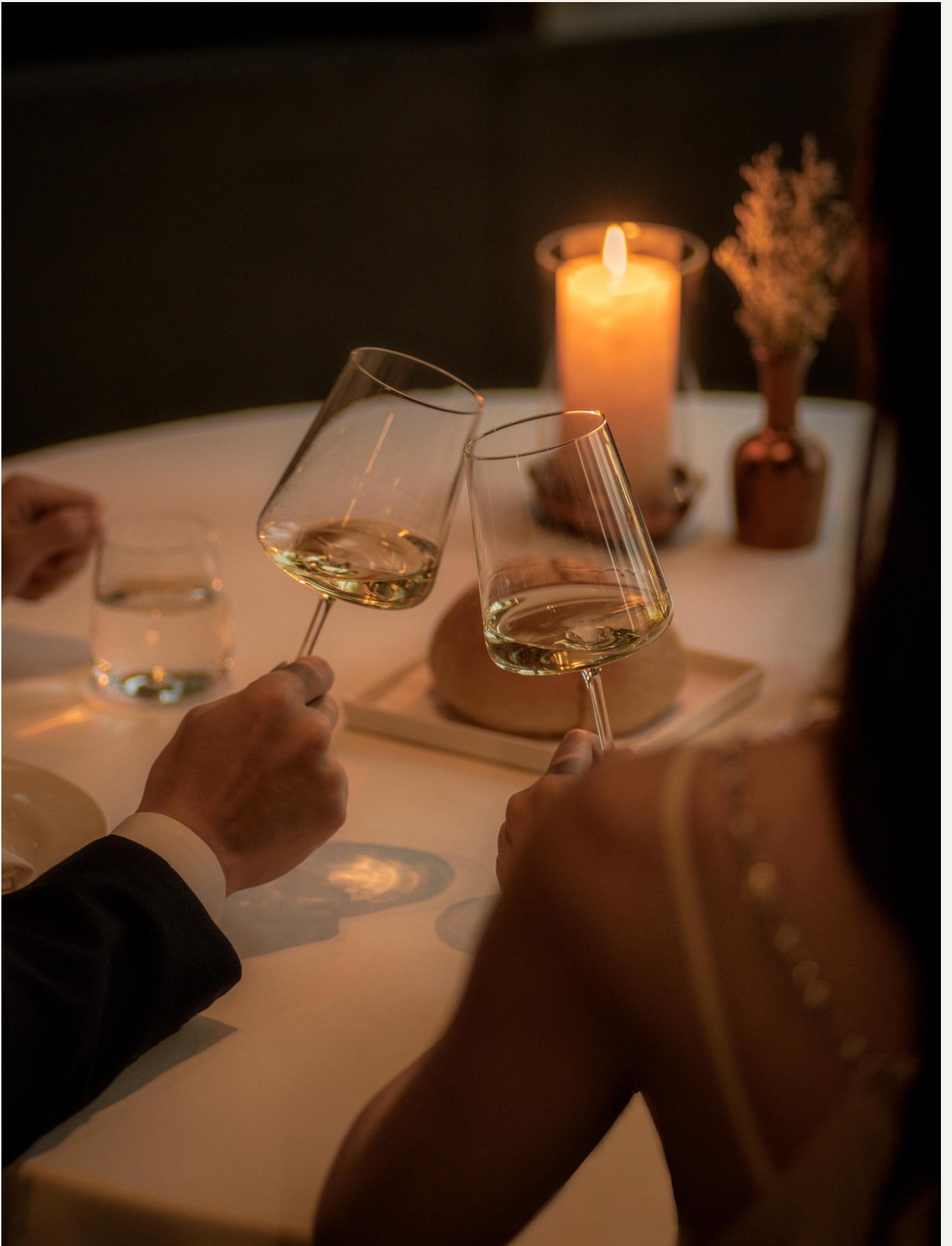
