

Amanoi

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Amanoi is a contemporary beachside resort with 27 freestanding guest Pavilions and Villas, two Spa Houses and six Residences. Embraced by Nui Chua National Park on the dramatic coastline of Vinh Hy Bay, the property features a lakeside Aman Spa and a Beach Club on the private sandy shoreline.

Amanoi ('place of peace') is a contemporary beachside resort with 9 freestanding guest Pavilions, 18 Villas with private pools, two Spa Houses and six Residences. Overlooking Vinh Hy Bay on Vietnam's dramatic central coast, the property is embraced by Nui Chua National Park and features a lakeside Aman Spa. The property enjoys magnificent views from its cliff-top infinity pool and Central Pavilion; down on the private sandy shoreline, the Beach Club includes a dining area and a second swimming pool.

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Combining the Sanskrit-derived word for 'peace' with *noi*, meaning 'place' in Vietnamese, Amanoi is a contemporary beachside resort with 9 guest Pavilions, 18 Villas with private pools, six Residences and two Spa Houses. Overlooking Vinh Hy Bay on Vietnam's dramatic central coast, the property is embraced by Nui Chua National Park and features a lakeside Aman Spa. Magnificent views unfold from the spectacular hilltop infinity pool and the Central Pavilion, which houses the Restaurant, Bar and library. Down on the shore, the Beach Club, with its dining area and second swimming pool, overlooks a private swathe of golden sand.

Meaning 'peaceful place', Amanoi is a contemporary beachside resort with 9 guest Pavilions, 18 Pool Villas, six Residences and two Spa Houses. Overlooking Vinh Hy Bay on Vietnam's dramatic central coast, the property is embraced by Nui Chua National Park.

Set high on a wide promontory, Amanoi lies 55 kilometres south of Cam Ranh Airport in a region renowned for its spectacular mountain and coastal scenery. Magnificent views unfold from the hilltop infinity pool and the Central Pavilion, which houses the Restaurant, the Bar and a library. Down on the shore, the Beach Club, with its dining area and second swimming pool, overlooks a private sandy beach, lapped by the coral-rich waters of a marine reserve.

Impressive views are a feature of all Amanoi's accommodation, which captures vistas of Nui Chua National Park, the property's lake, Vinh Hy Bay and the East Sea. The freestanding Pavilions offer a combined living and sleeping area and a timber sundeck with sun loungers; Pool Villas also feature a private pool of up to 36 square metres.

The Residences each consist of two to five freestanding bedroom pavilions, living and dining pavilions, and a large private swimming pool. A 24/7 personal butler meets all guests' needs. Residences are set on the hillside, with one located at the Beach Club.

Set by Amanoi's lotus-filled lake, two Spa Houses – one featuring a Moroccan hammam; the other a Russian banya – allow guests to enjoy therapies in complete seclusion. As well as their authentic bath houses, each includes a large private pool, a plunge pool and a Jacuzzi. Nearby, the main Aman Spa includes five double treatment rooms, two hydrotherapy suites, relaxation pavilions and a finishing salon. Fitness options include a light-filled gym, a Pilates studio, a yoga pavilion set over the water, and two tennis courts.

Combining the Sanskrit-derived word for 'peace' with *noi*, meaning 'place' in Vietnamese, Amanoi is a contemporary beachside resort with 9 guest Pavilions, 18 Pool Villas, six Residences and two Spa Houses. Overlooking Vinh Hy Bay on Vietnam's dramatic central coast, the property is embraced by Nui Chua National Park.

The National Park is part of Ninh Thuan Province, renowned for its majestic mountain ranges and spectacular coastline. Adjoining the national Park, a marine reserve is home to a large variety of sea corals, tropical fish species, and hawksbill and green sea turtles. Here in this wildlife-rich setting, Amanoi sits on a wide, mountainous promontory, 55 kilometres south of Cam Ranh Airport.

Impressive views are a feature of all Amanoi's accommodation, which captures vistas of the lush national park, the property's lotus-filled lake, Vinh Hy Bay and the East Sea beyond. Fusing contemporary elegance with traditional Vietnamese architectural styles, the freestanding Pavilions – with lake, mountain or ocean views – offer a combined living and sleeping area and a timber sundeck with sun loungers; Ocean and Mountain Pool Villas also feature a private pool of up to 36 square metres. All include a kingsize bed, sofa, writing desk, LCD TV, sound docking system, wifi, minibar and an espresso machine.

Residences are set on the hillside, with one – the Bay View Residence – located at the Beach Club, and consist of two to five freestanding bedroom pavilions, living and dining pavilions, and a large private swimming pool. A 24/7 personal butler meets all guests' needs, including the preparation of Vietnamese or Western cuisine in the Residence's private kitchen.

Set by Amanoi's lotus-filled lake, two Spa Houses – one featuring a Moroccan hammam; the other a Russian banya – allow guests to enjoy a spa environment in complete seclusion. As well as their authentic bath houses, each Spa House includes a large private pool, a plunge pool and a Jacuzzi, along with expansive outdoor lounging areas. Nearby, the main Aman Spa includes five double treatment rooms, four with outdoor terraces; two hydrotherapy suites, each with a heated stone treatment table, a steam room,

Jacuzzi and cold plunge pool; hand and foot therapy rooms; and a finishing salon. Fitness options include a light-filled gym, a Pilates studio, a yoga pavilion set over the water, and two tennis courts.

Guest accommodation is joined to the resort's facilities by pathways winding through coastal rocks and vegetation. Magnificent views unfold from the hilltop infinity pool and the Central Pavilion, which houses the Restaurant, the Bar and a library. Down on the shore, the Beach Club, with its dining area and second swimming pool, overlooks a private sandy beach.

Serving Vietnamese and international cuisines, the Restaurant lies at the heart of the Central Pavilion. Elegant and spacious, its air-conditioned interior opens on to shaded alfresco dining areas. The Bar is set beneath soaring eaves with views of rolling hills and distant mountains. From its lofty perch, the Central Pavilion's expansive terrace offers superb views of the East Sea and the rugged coastline.
