AMANUSA



On Bali's Nusa Dua peninsula, all that separates Amanusa's thatched Suites and Villas from their private stretch of Indian Ocean coastline are the fairways of Bali National Golf Club. Creating a sense of complete seclusion, this serene swathe of green is enhanced by a design ethos firmly rooted in Balinese heritage. From the 11th-century temple nearby to Amanusa's paras-stone walls and old frangipani trees surrounding the main pool, traditions and Hindu influences abound. Along with priority access to the country's best golf course, guests can unwind at the spa, on the tennis courts, or in a *bale* at the elegant Beach Club.

Location

- Amanusa sits on southern Bali's Nusa Dua peninsula, overlooking the Indian Ocean.
- Nusa Dua is renowned for its palm-fringed, white-sand beaches, sophisticated dining scene and bustling streets lined with shops selling textiles and crafts

Getting There

- Amanusa is a 20-minute drive from Denpasar Airport, which connects with major cities across Southeast Asia, Australia and the Middle East
- Transfers from the airport to Amanusa are complimentary



Accommodation

Comprising 31 along-along-thatched Suites and six Villas, Amanusa's guest rooms all enjoy a tropical setting with easy access to the golf course and the Beach Club. All include voile-draped four-posters and sunken bathtubs, along with private gardens containing daybeds, sun canopies and a table for alfresco dining.

- Garden Suites feature a private tropical setting
- Deluxe Suites enjoy views of the ocean or golf course

Pool Suite

- Ocean, golf course or garden views
- Private 8.5-metre pool

Villas

- Private residence laid out over two storeys with views stretching across gardens and the golf course
- Lounge-dining area, library and garage
- Private 25-metre pool surrounded by loungers
- Personal chef and butlers, large open-air dining pavilion seating 10 (12 in the six-bedroom Villa)



Dining

The Terrace

Capacity: 50

- Sweeping views of the golf course, the Indian Ocean, Nusa Dua and the Bukit Peninsula
- Serves Thai, Indonesian, Vietnamese and Western cuisines
- Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner

The Italian Restaurant

Capacity: 40

- Set in an elegant room with high ceilings and leaded windows, with an outdoor courtyard overlooking the pool
- Serves Italian cuisine, dinner only

The Bar

Capacity: 30

- Wonderful views stretching across the golf course to the sandy coastline
- Offers casual dining throughout the day and afternoon tea; the ideal spot for sundowners

The Swimming Pool

Capacity: 16 seated, plus four bales and eight loungers

- An alternative venue by the 30-metre pool, offering alfresco dining beneath a frangipani-draped colonnade
- Lunchtime fare includes sandwiches, salads and traditional Indonesian snacks

The Beach Club

Capacity: six seated, plus eight bales and 16 loungers

- Open for lunch, afternoon snacks and refreshments
- Provides a romantic setting for private candlelit dinners and sunrise breakfasts



Relaxation and Fitness

Tennis centre

- Amanusa's two all-weather courts are floodlit for evening play
- Playing partners and ball boys can be arranged
- A thatched *bale* between the courts provides iced chrysanthemum tea and other refreshments between play

Spa

- Overlooking the peninsula with an adjacent open-air relaxation area, the spa suite offers therapies from massages to salt scrubs and clay body wraps, along with reiki and reflexology on request
- Treatments are also available in-suite, or in a beach *bale*

The Beach Club

- Fringed by a coral reef, the private sandy beach is furnished with loungers and *bales*, and includes a relaxed dining venue
- The setting is ideal for snorkelling, kayaking, sailing and surfing



Other Facilities

Library

- Specialises in books on Indonesian art and culture
- A selection of novels, magazines, newspapers, CDs, DVDs and board games are also available

Boutique

- Offering a unique selection of Balinese and Indonesian jewellery, indigenous handicrafts, gift items and resort wear

Meetings and Celebrations

- Meeting facilities accommodate up to 30 people and comprise a boardroom that divides into conference and reception spaces
- Facilities include direct lines for fax and telephone, a video and CD system, satellite TV and a computer-linked projector and screen
- Amanusa is a special venue for occasions such as weddings, anniversary celebrations, birthdays and family reunions. Events may be held at the private Beach Club or Pool Courtyard

Activities

Golf

- Amanusa lies within reach of some of the world's most spectacular courses, and provides guests with complimentary golf clubs
- Amanusa guests enjoy priority access to the Bali National Golf Club, one of Asia's top five courses
- Nirwana Bali Golf Club is an hour away, and was designed by former British Open champion Greg Norman amid rice paddies, tropical forest, gardens and creeks, with five holes alongside the ocean
- New Kuta Golf is a 30-minute drive from Amanusa, offering five sets of tees and challenging all skill levels
- Set in an extinct volcano, Bali Handara Country Club offers a championship course in one of the world's most arresting settings, 1.5 hours from Amanusa

Cycling

- The terrain of Nusa Dua is ideal for relaxed cycling along bougainvillea-shaded lanes
- Guests can use Amanusa's bicycles for exploring alone or on guided mountain and village excursions tailored to personal fitness levels and interests

Cruising

- A variety of sailing craft, including a catamaran, can be chartered to visit Nusa Lembongan, an island around 20km offshore, just visible from Amanusa
- This full-day excursion can include a lunchtime barbecue and exploration of the beach, as well as snorkelling and relaxation

Cultural tours

- Amanusa's most popular excursion, Luhur Uluwatu is one of Bali's *sad kahyangan* – Six Great Temples – perched high above the sea on an enormous limestone outcrop
- Amanusa drivers and guides are available to escort guests to Luhur Uluwatu and on other personalised tours to sites of cultural interest around the island

Shopping

- The nearby beach districts of Kuta, Legian, Seminyak and Sanur are renowned for their restaurants and bars as well as shops selling antiques, handicrafts, fashion and souvenirs
- Denpasar, Bali's capital and commercial centre, has a major market and museum, as well as antiques shops and boutiques, all within easy reach of Amanusa
- Amanusa's guest assistants can create shopping itineraries tailored to guests' individual needs

Surfing and water sports

- From November to March, Nusa Dua is an excellent surfing destination, with a barrier reef creating waves a few hundred metres offshore
- During the season, Amanusa can arrange lessons in surfing, windsurfing and stand-up paddleboarding (SUP)
- Hobie Cats and other craft can be hired for a guided sailing excursion to the greater Sanur beach area

Fishing

- Traditional Balinese jukungs and larger boats are available to charter for fishing trips out of Sanur
