Venues

Amandari offers a variety of venues that combine indoor elegance with alfresco settings. Opting for an exclusive buyout guarantees your own private sanctuary for multi-day celebrations filled with personalised activities, where every aspect of your event's journey is meticulously considered. Whether it's a pre-wedding gathering, a sunset ceremony or a glamorous reception beneath the starlit sky, we ensure your vision is seamlessly brought to life while you simply relish every moment. The Restaurant

Overlooking Amandari's swimming pool with panoramic views of the Ayung River Valley, the open-air restaurant serves Balinese heritage cuisine, Indonesian fare and a range of international dishes for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Every evening, rindik musicians perform their melodies in the golden pavilion, adding to the ambience.

Terrace Bar

Glowing with soft light, the Terrace Bar rests adjacent to the pool, overlooking the Ayung River Valley, making it the ideal location for a seated meal with scenic views or a sunset cocktail reception.

Poolside

Amandari's main swimming pool acts as a lounge-lined outdoor sanctuary where time slows down and sunny afternoons unfold in step with the easy pace of Ubud life. Amandari's shimmering centrepiece is a can accommodate an atmospheric ceremony, cocktail reception and dinner reception, requiring a buy out of the resort for minimum of two nights to use the main pool as an event venue.

Amandari Three-Bedroom Villa

The Amandari Three-Bedroom Villa is a serene Balinese-style home surrounded by cascading rice terraces and beautiful views of the Ayung River Valley. Composed of five free-standing pavilions, a landscaped garden and a two-tiered swimming pool, the villa features three detached terrace-style bedrooms and a kitchen for entertaining.

Consummate privacy can be found here, whether admiring a trio of surrounding peaks from the terrace, dining in the open-air bale or retreating in the glass-walled living room. The property, serviced by two staff, is situated a minute's drive from Amandari, with a dedicated vehicle on hand to ensure amenities are always within reach.

Amandari One-Bedroom Villa

The Amandari One-Bedroom Villa offers a tranquil retreat in Ubud's cultural heartland. An outdoor dining pavilion, spacious tropical garden and a private infinity pool make the most of the serene surrounding landscape, while inside, organic materials such as coconut and teak wood have been used to reflect the natural island setting. For larger groups, the expansive separate living pavilion can be transformed into a second bedroom, and a further bedroom can be arranged by connecting the villa to an adjacent Valley Pavilion.

Secret Garden

Ceremonies

Amandari's spectacular setting, unique architecture and natural surroundings means that almost every turn reveals yet another setting suitable for exchanging or renewing your vows. Ceremonies can be held poolside, in the secret garden or at the villa for smaller groups, to name just a few of the intimate settings.



Say 'I Do'

To officially say 'I do' in a ceremony at Amandari, it is necessary to submit documents including birth certificates, proof of citizenship, copies of passports and a Certificate of No Impediment. All documents must be legally translated into English and Indonesian, stamped with an apostille and submitted to the registry office beforehand. The resort team can assist with every step of this process.





Exclusive use of Amandari

With its own character, intimate spaces, a limited number of rooms and intuitive, personalised service, Amandari provides the perfect opportunity for guests to take the entire resort as a unique venue for a special occasion. At Amandari, enquiries from 31 free-standing rooms, accommodating up to 62 guests, are considered a full resort buyout. Buy outs are not available during the summer months of July and August.

Accommodation

Reflecting the classic Ubud style of architecture, Amandari's thatched-roof pavilions are fronted by stone gateways and open on three sides via sliding glass doors, leading to lush garden courtyards. For those seeking a little more space, the Amandari Three-Bedroom Villa is surrounded by cascading rice terraces and beautiful views of the Ayung River Valley, offering consummate privacy for guests seeking an authentic Balinese experience.

The Amandari Villa is a serene Balinese-style home with five pavilions, rice terrace views, and a two-tiered pool.

Garden Pavilion

Relaxation and wellness

Village artisans

Ubud is Bali's artistic heart, full of galleries and home to many artists. Nearby, visit the tucked-away villages of silversmiths, wood carvers and Balinese painters, or spend a peaceful morning or afternoon with a working artist in a private painting session at Amandari, creating anything from a simple local shrine to a colourful natural scene of the hotel's surroundings.

Island of the gods

Sacred springs, shrines and statues dot the Ayung River Valley, and regular festivals give the decorated villages a carnival-like atmosphere. Amandari can arrange private excursions to ancient temples, personalised blessings and walks that reveal the spiritual side of Balinese culture.

Explore nearby temples

Ubud is full of world-famous temples. From Pura Taman Saraswati, in the centre of town, to the holy springs of Pura Tirta Empul and a host of other lesser-known sacred sites, a trip to Amandari offers the chance to immerse yourself in Bali's deep-rooted spiritual culture.

On winding trails

Discover the island's countryside with our expert local guides. Trek along a ridge high above the river, with banyan trees framing views across the gorge, or mountain bike through forests and rice paddies. Our remote hillside bale – with its spectacular, secluded views – is also ideal for private picnics.

Balinese dance and gamelan class

Ibu Agung, our talented in-house dance teacher, has been part of the Amandari family for more than 30 years. She comes to the resort daily to teach the local children Balinese dance, while her son – the local music teacher – teaches the art of the gamelan. You can watch the children practice at the Lotus Pond Pavilion during the week.
