Amanwana, the Peaceful Forest, is located on Moyo, an island paradise east of Bali that officially became Indonesia's 55th National Park in August 2022. Set on a beach overlooking the turquoise waters of a protected marine park, this full-board wilderness hideaway features 17 luxury guest tents, a beachside restaurant, a tranquil spa, and its own Dive Centre. Perfect for private buyouts, transforming the camp into your personal Eden, Amanwana offers unparalleled access to some of the finest scuba diving and snorkeling in Indonesia. Inland, the island boasts cascading waterfalls, hidden caves, and abundant birdlife. With its enchanting landscape, Amanwana provides an idyllic setting for celebrating life's milestones, whether for an intimate gathering or a grand affair.



Venues

Embracing its natural surroundings, Amanwana offers open-air venues designed for unforgettable alfresco experiences. Opting for an exclusive buyout guarantees your own private sanctuary for multi-day celebrations filled with personalised activities, where every aspect of your event's journey is meticulously considered. The Restaurant

Boardwalk

Say 'I Do'

To officially say 'I do' in a ceremony at Amanwana, it is necessary to submit documents including birth certificates, proof of citizenship, copies of passports and a Certificate of No Impediment. All documents must be legally translated into English and Indonesian, stamped with an apostille and submitted to the registry office beforehand. The resort team can assist with every step of this process.





Exclusive use of Amanwana

With its own character, intimate spaces, a limited number of rooms and intuitive, personalised service, Amanwana provides the perfect opportunity for guests to take the entire resort as a unique venue for a special occasion. At Amanwana, enquiries from 17 free-standing tents, accommodating up to 40 guests, are considered a full resort buyout. Buy outs are not available during the summer months of July and August.

Accommodation

Embracing the essence of a wilderness hideaway, Amanwana's tented suites are nestled along the shoreline or within the tropical forest, offering a seamless connection to nature. Each tent features solid walls, hardwood floors, and soaring canvas ceilings, complemented by an elegant writing desk and Indonesian artworks, creating a sleek, Asian-inspired take on safari chic. For a more expansive retreat, the camp's exclusive buyout option transforms Amanwana into your private paradise, perfect for creating unforgettable moments amidst the untouched beauty of Moyo Island.



Ocean Front Tent

Standing directly on the shoreline, each 58-square-metre (624-square-foot) Ocean Front Tent opens to uninterrupted views of the Flores Sea. Here, dawn breaks to the sound of waves, and mornings begin with the horizon unfolding before you. Inside, a king-sized bed, soft seating area and a spacious bathroom with dressing area invite unhurried living, while picture windows frame the shifting seascape. Hardwood floors and coral stone ground the interior, as artworks from neighbouring Sumbawa bring the spirit of the surrounding islands within.

Jungle Tent

Resting beneath a tropical canopy, each 58-square-metre (624-square-foot) Jungle Tent offers a serene escape where nature sets the rhythm. Surrounded by lush greenery, mornings begin with birdsong drifting through picture windows framing the forest, while coffee is savoured on the private terrace. Inside, proportion and texture define the space: a generous king-sized bed, living area, and large bathroom with dressing area, enriched with wood, stone, and artistic details. The result is a retreat designed for stillness, reflection, and comfort.


Ocean View Tent

Balancing the forest's embrace with the sea's horizon, each 58-square-metre (624-square-foot) tent offers subtle glimpses of the Flores Sea beyond the treeline. Mornings begin with sunlight streaming through wide picture windows, while the gentle sound of waves drifts softly in the background. A king-sized bed and generous seating create a serene atmosphere, complemented by an en-suite bathroom and dressing area. Slightly inland yet close to the beach, each tent features an outdoor seating area for breakfast or evening drinks as the sea's colours shift.



Relaxation and wellness

The Spa at Amanwana is a wilderness hideaway forgotten by time, surrounded by the turquoise water and untouched reefs of the Flores Sea. Amidst the beauty of the island's nature, here one can take the time and space to reconnect with your inner self. Not your traditional spa, Amanwana offers an alternative to the regime and routine. The Spa was conceived and created to blend Indonesian-influenced techniques with the best of the East and the West.

The resort sits on Moyo Island, part of Moyo Satonda National Park, with access to protected marine areas offering world-class diving. Nearby, Tambora National Park and Komodo National Park offer extraordinary landscapes and wildlife, including the famous Komodo dragons.

Active Adventures

Amanwana offers adventure both on and offshore, with watersports like kayaking and paddleboarding, a PADI Dive Centre for all levels, and snorkelling guides to explore vibrant marine life. On land, trekking and cycling routes lead to stunning vistas, limestone pools, and a bat cave, providing opportunities for wildlife encounters across Moyo Island.


Wild Fauna

Moyo Satonda National Park, known for its diverse landscapes, is a haven for wildlife. Its tropical forests host colourful birdlife, including the endangered yellow-crested cockatoo, sea eagles, and ospreys. On land, you may spot rusa deer, macaques, and wild boar, while beneath the surface, vibrant corals and marine life, including turtles, manta rays, and whale sharks, await.

Whale Sharks

Located east of Moyo Island, Saleh Bay is home to the world's second-largest whale shark population, with 99 known inhabitants. Recognized by UNESCO as part of its Biosphere Reserve, whale sharks can be spotted year-round. Guests can embark on a bespoke excursion, including a sunrise cruise, picnic breakfast, and all necessary snorkeling and diving equipment.





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
