The legend of Kang Chi Wei is brought to life through a dance performance by the three-tiered pool. It tells the love story between King Sri Jaya Pangus of the Balingkang Kingdom and Kang Chi Wei, the daughter of a Chinese merchant.

For a long time, King Jaya Pangus and Kang Chi Wei's union was not blessed with a child. Saddened, the king sought enlightenment but became stranded at the foot of Mount Batur. While meditating, he was met and seduced by Dewi Danu, the water goddess of Lake Batur. The king fell in love and married Dewi Danu, but Kang Chi Wei discovered the marriage.

A fight ensued between Dewi Danu and Kang Chi Wei, each using their respective powers. Unable to abandon his love for Kang Chi Wei, King Jaya Pangus protected her from Dewi Danu's attacks. Seeing them united, Dewi Danu became angry and cursed them into statues.

The iconic Balinese dance features a troupe of 40 men and depicts an epic battle from the Ramayana, in which the monkey-like Vanara join Prince Rama in fighting the evil King Ravana. The troupe surrounds a large bonfire and begins chanting slowly and quietly. A cacophony of cak cak cak sounds gradually builds to a powerful crescendo. The chorus of chanting incorporates seven distinct rhythms, each intricately interwoven to create a rich and complex soundscape.
